WHEREAS, Guam seeks to educate and raise awareness of bullying prevention efforts through specific events like the first BASTA (Bullying Affects Students, Teachers, and All) Bullying Prevention Conference; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Charles P.E. Leitch is an attorney and the founding principal of Patterson, Buchanan, Fobes, Leitch & Kalzer with over fifteen (15) years experience in litigation; and
