**Relative to recognizing and commending Mr. Terry L. Dozier for his outstanding contribution to the BASTA Bullying Prevention Conference and for joining in the promotion and educational outreach component of bullying prevention in Guam.**

**1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'***  
**2 *TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

**3 WHEREAS,** Guam has joined communities across the country to celebrate  
**4 National Bullying Prevention Month, during the month of October, in order to**  
**5 promote bullying prevention within our schools and community to support the**  
**6 needs of children; and**

**7 WHEREAS,** it has been shown that community involvement and education  
**8 is critical in effectively reducing the occurrences of bullying and in encouraging**  
**9 more acceptable behavior from our children through the promotion of positive**  
**10 behavioral alternatives to bullying; and**

**11 WHEREAS,** Guam seeks to educate and raise awareness of  
**12 bullying prevention efforts through specific events like the first BASTA (Bullying**  
**13 Affects Students, Teachers, and All) Bullying Prevention Conference; and**

**14 WHEREAS,** Mr. Terry L. Dozier is a retired National Basketball  
**15 Association (NBA) player, who was recruited from the University of South**  
**16 Carolina to play with the Charlotte Hornets; and**

1           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Terry L. Dozier has overcome the adversity of an  
2 impoverished childhood to become an internationally recognized role model for  
3 children and young athletes by using his accomplishments as an example of how  
4 obstacles can be overcome through hard work and dedication; and

5           **WHEREAS**, his life experiences have shaped Mr. Terry L. Dozier's  
6 personal philosophies and instilled in him a genuine concern for his fellow man  
7 and a desire to share the knowledge he has gained through his experiences; and

8           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Terry L. Dozier has used his celebrity status to participate  
9 in educational outreach and motivational speaking for the purpose of encouraging  
10 others to engage in positive behaviors that will result in improved circumstances  
11 for society; and

12           **WHEREAS**, members of the Judiciary of Guam and the Guam Department  
13 of Education invited Mr. Terry L. Dozier to attend the BASTA Bullying  
14 Prevention Conference as a guest speaker to provide educational outreach aimed at  
15 reducing bullying and cyberbullying in our communities; now, therefore, be it

16           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina' Trentai Unu Na*  
17 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the  
18 people of Guam, encourage the people of Guam to join in recognizing the  
19 contributions of Terry L. Dozier for his commitment to being a part of the solution  
20 to preventing bullying in Guam through his participation as a guest speaker at the  
21 BASTA Bullying Prevention Conference; and be it further

22           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on  
23 Rules certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that  
24 copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Chief Justice F. Philip Carbullido,
