7 WHEREAS, Dr. Perez is a Professor Emeritus of Neuroscience at the 8 University of Philippines; a consultant to the Department of Neuroscience University 9 of the Philippines-Philippine General Hospital Medical Center and Makati Medical 10 Center; a member of the Advisory Council of the Brain Foundation of the Philippines 11 and an adviser to the Multiple Sclerosis Society of the Philippines and the 12 Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis Society of the Philippines; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Perez is a pioneer in the organization of the first formal
Residency Training Program in Neurology in the Philippines at University of
Philippines –Philippine General Hospital Medical Center in 1973 organized
the formation of the Makati Medical Center Residency Training Program in
17 1980; and

WHERERAS, Dr. Perez is one (1) of the twelve (12) founding members who
actively sought to organize and integrate neurologists from various universities in the
Philippines resulting in the formation of the Philippine Neurological Association of
the Philippines in 1972; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Perez was instrumental integrating the Sections of Neurology (Department of Medicine), Neurosurgery (Department of Surgery) and Neurophysiology (Department of Physiology) were integrated under one umbrella through the formation of the Department of Neurosciences, University of the

Philippines and Dr. Perez' efforts were recognized and honored by his appointment as
 the first Chairman of the Department of Neurosciences in 1999 – 2001; and

3 WHEREAS, Dr. Perez was actively involved in transforming the Neuroscience 4 curriculum into the problem-based and integrated curriculum that it presently is; and

5 WHEREAS, Dr. Perez' empathy for the plight of his patients, especially those with grave conditions, engendered him to organize support groups composed of 6 family members, patients and neurologists. Thus were the following societies formed: 7 8 Myasthenia Gravis Society of the Philippines, Multiple Sclerosis Society of the 9 Philippines, Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Society of the Philippines, and 10 Philippine League Against Epilepsy (PLAE). The PLAE is the national chapter of the International League Against Epilepsy and is now recognized as the expert source of 11 12 information and continuing professional education in the care of persons with The organization has also successfully implemented projects bringing 13 epilepsy. epilepsy to the grass roots, a vision that is continuously, actively being pursued; and 14

WHEREAS, Dr. Perez recognized the need to give financial assistance to indigent patients of Neurology in University of the Philippines-Philippine General Hospital Medical Center and the need to give financial support for Neurology and Neurosurgery graduates in their pursuit of subspecialty training here and abroad and the need to establish a Neuroscience library; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Perez's extensive knowledge and experience in Neurology will be beneficial for diabetes treatment and prevention and be helpful to the people of Guam;

WHEREAS, Guam is proud and honored to welcome Dr. Martesio C. Perez to
be a Guest Speaker at the Twelfth (12th) Annual Guam Diabetes Association
Conference to share his expertise in diabetes with the people of Guam; now,
