


1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY COMMITTEE ON RULES OF**
2 ***IMINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, the U.S. Departments of Education and State have announced
4 the 12th annual International Education Week is Novembers 14 - 18, 2011. This
5 year's theme is International Education: Inspiring Students Locally to Succeed
6 Globally;

7 **WHEREAS**, international education promotes programs that will prepare
8 Guam students for a global environment – the sharing of ideas and experiences
9 across borders, and encourages them to participate in international education and
10 exchange, so they can gain the knowledge and experiences to help them contribute
11 to our state's economic competitiveness and security;

12 **WHEREAS**, the need to provide all of our children with educational
13 opportunities that will enable them to succeed in a globally competitive economy
14 where knowledge and innovation are more important than ever; and, where the
15 world's economies and societies are becoming more and more interdependent;

1 **WHEREAS**, in order to give Guam students an outstanding education, we
2 must work together, including learning about global partners — their cultures,
3 histories, languages values and viewpoints. We must focus on integrating
4 international perspectives into classrooms, provide global learning and
5 international exchange; now, therefore, be it

6 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guahan* does
7 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam recognize and promotes international
8 education and exchange, and the Guam Department of Education for celebrating
9 International Education Week, November 14-18, 2011.; now therefore be it

10 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on
11 Rules certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attests to, the adoption hereof
12 and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Taling Taitano, Acting

15 Education; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.
