Relative to the restoration and rededication of the "Justice Josephine Gofigan Taitague Memorial Park" in Umatac, in commemoration and remembrance of Guam's littlest hero, Justice Taitague, whose memorable battle with cancer inspired many to join in this worthwhile cause.

- 3 WHEREAS, Justice Josephine Gofigan Taitague was diagnosed in
- 4 August 2002 with T-cell lymphoma, a cancer of the white blood cells, her
- 5 illness and bravery touching the hearts of the community of Guam as the
- 6 island's first ever "Bone Marrow Drive" was conducted, a transplant of
- 7 bone marrow being the treatment necessary to save her life; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the community's concern for young Justice prompted
- 9 thousands of people of Guam to be voluntarily tested to see if they were a
- 10 bone marrow match for Justice, and many also donated to what would
- 11 become the "Justice Foundation," raising money to care for other similarly
- 12 afflicted children; and

WHEREAS, despite the best efforts of her doctors and the community, little Justice succumbed to her illness before a matching donor could be found, and passed away on February 9, 2003 at just five years old; and

WHEREAS, Justice's short life deeply touched so many that even after her passing, work continued in her name, including establishment of the "Guam's National Bone Marrow Registry" and passage of Public Law 27-134 on December 30, 2004, which officially named the children's playground behind the Umatac Mayor's Office the "Justice Josephine Gofigan Taitague Memorial Park," to keep her memory alive; and

WHEREAS, in the years since 2004, sun damage, severe storms, and other natural occurrences had damaged the original playground equipment to the extent that it became unusable; and

WHEREAS, the people of Guam are once again joining together to remember Justice and honor her through the repair and rededication of the "Justice Josephine Gofigan Taitague Memorial Park"; and

WHEREAS, local telecommunications company IT&E has been a major sponsor in the providing of playground equipment for Guam's children throughout the island, and has also adopted the "Justice Josephine Gofigan Taitague Memorial Park" in Umatac; and

WHEREAS, the "Justice Josephine Gofigan Taitague Memorial Park" has been restored to its former glory and is ready for children to once again

- 1 create positive memories of childhood as they play in the park named for
- 2 the brave little girl who will be able to join them only in spirit; and
- WHEREAS, the people, and especially the children of Guam, come
- 4 together on this day to celebrate the re-opening of the newly restored
- 5 "Justice Josephine Gofigan Taitague Memorial Park"; now, therefore, be it

- 10 Committee; parents Anthony and Lynn Taitague; the community of
- 11 Umatac; and the many people who have contributed to the Justice
- 12 Foundation; and be it further
