BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA' TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÂHAN:

- WHEREAS, In August 1974, Mr. Pascual V. Artero began his exceptional
- 4 career at the Department of Parks and Recreation where he was a Recreation
- 5 Assistant whose duties included planning and coordinating different intramurals,
- 6 tournament leagues and special activities including participation in the youth
- 7 center program; and

- WHEREAS, in April 1980, Mr. Artero began working at the Department of
- 9 Corrections as a Corrections Officer 1, where he participated in the lawful
- protection of the occupants of the building from outside annoyance and in
- coordinating basketball activities for various groups of inmates as part of their
- 12 physical fitness program; and

WHEREAS, in August 1981, Mr. Artero continued his outstanding work as 1 an instructor in physical education at Father Duenas Memorial High School by 2 3 providing daily kinesthetic teaching to students in the classroom and in various 4 sports and physical exercises; and 5 WHEREAS, in June 1982, Mr. Artero began working for the Department of Youth Affairs as a Youth Service Worker 1, where he organized group discussions 6 for clients and participated in developing and implementing physical fitness 7 8 programs for clients; and WHEREAS, in May 1984, Mr. Artero continued his exceptional work as a 9 Youth Service Worker II by assisting in planning and coordinating activities such 10 as the federally funded Energy Survey Program and supervised counseled and 11 coordinated activities for clients assigned to the Cottage Home; and 12 WHEREAS, in June 1986, Mr. Artero became a Program Coordinator 1 13 14 where he developed and coordinated a myriad of youth and community programs including the Guam Summer Youth Employment & Training Program, Youth 15 16 Month, Youth Employment Opportunities, Cultural Unity Day, Energy Survey Program, Job Search Program, Physical Fitness Program, Stay in School Program, 17 18 and the Youth Parade Program; and 19 WHEREAS, in July 1991, Mr. Artero continued his excellent work as a Program Coordinator II in the technical planning, development, coordination and 20 implementation of Federal and/or locally funded youth, community programs and 21 activities through research and analyzing data, interviews with appropriate 22 officials, program budgetary review, and in ensuring that all rules, policies and 23 regulations are adhered to, and programs, goals and objectives are well understood; 24 25 and WHEREAS, in February 1996, Mr. Artero became Program Coordinator III 26 where he supervised and implemented all aspects related to the development, 27

coordination, and implementation of Federal and/or locally funded youth and 1 2 community programs and in the direct observation and evaluation of the programs to determine effectiveness and to recommend or improve program requirements; 3 4 and WHEREAS, from March 22, 2010 to May 11, 2010, Mr. Artero became the 5 Acting Director of the Department of Youth Affairs where he diligently worked to 6 provide direction in the daily operations and management of the Department of 7 Youth Affairs, formulated plans and policies, coordinated and implemented 8 9 programs and services to enable youth to develop their leadership, sportsmanship, 10 and citizenship; and 11 WHEREAS, from September 2009 to January 13, 2012, Mr. Artero has continued his outstanding work as the Juvenile Justice Specialist/Program 12 Coordinator III at the Department of Youth Affairs where he continues to 13 14 administer and monitor federal and local youth projects, administer and monitor local correctional and law enforcement policies, coordinate juvenile justice 15 strategic planning efforts and oversee grant monies, compile data on juvenile crime 16 problems, consult with the Director and government officials regarding juvenile 17 programs and youth support services, plan and evaluate departmental efforts to 18 reduce disproportionate minority contact in the juvenile justice system, and ensure 19 that programs have a positive impact on its targeted population; and 20 WHEREAS, throughout his illustrious career Mr. Artero has received 21 numerous awards and certificates for his many professional achievements and 22 participation at youth and grant related conferences; and 23 **WHEREAS**, these awards and certificates along with Mr. Artero's 24 significant body of work at the Department of Parks and Recreation, the 25 Department of Corrections, Father Duenas Memorial High School, and the 26

Department of Youth Affairs has made him an important altruistic asset to the 1 youth and residents of Guam; now therefore, be it 2 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina 'Trentai Unu Na* 3 4 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people of Guam, recognize and honor Mr. Pascual V. Artero for the invaluable 5 6 contributions he has made for over thirty-eight (38) years in social work, and does congratulate him on the occasion of his retirement, and does further extend a most 7 sincere Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'us Ma' åse to Mr. Pascual V.
