

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Jesus Aguon Aquiningoc was born on October 10, 1932 and is the son of Juan and Concepcion Aquiningoc from the beautiful village of Umatac; and 2 WHEREAS, Mr. Jesus Aguon Aquiningoc, also known as "Jess" to close family 3 4 and friends, has ten (10) brothers and sisters: Juan, Rita, Christina, Jose, Maria, Carlos, Cecilia, Joaquin, Manuel and Larry; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Mr. Aguiningoc graduated from George Washington High School and soon afterwards started his career by joining the Department of Public Safety; and 7 WHEREAS, Mr. Aquiningoc joined the U.S. Navy in the year 1953 and received 8 9 commendations and awards to include the Good Conduct Medal (Seventh Award),

Letter of Commendation (COMNAVMARIANAS), Meritorious Unit commendation

(NAVMAG Guam), National Defense Service Medal, Korean Service Medal, United 11 Nations Service Medal, China Service Medal, Navy Commendation Medal; and 12 WHEREAS, in 1957, Mr. Aguiningoc married his first love, Maria Quinata 13 14 Sanchez of Umatac, the daughter of Joaquin and Milagro Sanchez; and WHEREAS, Mr. Aquiningoc and his wife Maria have four (4) beautiful children; 15 Leslie, Ruby, Mark and Rodney; and 16 WHEREAS, Mr. Aquiningoc successfully completed twenty-six (26) years of 17 Naval Service with his twilight tour at the office of Chief of Naval Information where 18 he served as the leading Chief Petty Officer of his Directorate, Pentagon, Washington, 19 D.C.; and 20 21 WHEREAS, upon completion of his Naval journey and the love for his home in the beautiful village of Umatac, Mr. Aquiningoc brought his family back to Guam in 22 1979; and 23 WHEREAS, Mr. Aquiningoc then continued to utilize his administrative skills as 24 the Administrative Personnel Officer at the University of Guam; and 25 WHEREAS, after a short tenure with the University of Guam, Mr. Aquiningoc 26 27 moved on to another calling as the Administrative Services Officer with the Department of Parks and Recreation; and 28

WHEREAS, while employed with the Department of Parks and Recreation, Mr. 29 Aquiningoc worked closely with then, First Lady Madeleine Bordallo on the 30 Beautification Task Force as the President; and 31 WHEREAS, Mr. Aquiningoc, who is always striving to service the community 32 33 and family, he was voted by his community to serve as Mayor for the beautiful village of Umatac; and 34 WHEREAS, while serving as Mayor, Mr. Aquiningoc's wife, Maria, had passed 35 on at which time he decided not to seek re-election, but yet he continued to service the 36 community in many ways; and 37 WHEREAS, while in Virginia, Mr. Aquiningoc served as the President of the 38 39 Guam Society of Norfolk, Virginia as well as in the Parish of San Dionisio, Umatac; he served as the President of the Parish Council and was a member of the Knights of 40 Columbus; and 41 WHEREAS, Mr. Aguiningoc is a very humble man, and well known for his 42 respect, generosity, kindness and caring ways to family, friends and all who came to 43 know him; and 44 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Aquiningoc and his wife, Maria share strong moral values 45 which were instilled upon their children: ..to love one another..that it's better to be rich 46 in friends than rich in money..to respect others in order to earn the respect of 47

others..treat others as you would want to be treated..be a good listener..serve others
