**RELATIVE TO CONGRATULATING THE

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I
MINA'TRENTAI UNU LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

1 **WHEREAS**, the Engineers, Architects and Surveyors Golf Club
2 (EASGC) was founded in 1991with its Constitution & By-Laws duly
3 adopted by the Board of Directors on January 27, 1991, then duly ratified by
4 the members on Feb 03, 1991 and approved by the Department of Revenue
5 & Taxation in March 1991; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the mission of EASGC is to encourage and promote the
7 game of golf, to encourage member participation in civic and community
8 functions and to support social functions for the members and fellow golfers;
9 and

10 **WHEREAS**, the organization currently has sixty-three (63) members
11 actively involved in carrying out the mission of EASGC; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the membership of the EASGC consists mainly of
13 engineers, architects, surveyors, business owners and executives and both
14 active and retired military service men; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the group meets every Sunday for a round of golf in any
16 scheduled golf courses around the island in order to foster a spirit of
17 camaraderie among its members; and

18 **WHEREAS**, EASGC holds a general membership meeting every first
19 Monday of the month at a designated hotel on island and for the last two
20 years has been holding its monthly meeting at the Guam Reef Hotel; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Engineers, Architects and Surveyors Club has been
22 hosting the JFT Island Wide Golf Tournament since 1994 to raise funds for
23 different charitable organizations, such as Make A Wish Foundation, Alee
24 Shelter, UOG Endowment Foundation, Kamalen Karidat, and Guam
25 Shriners; and

26 **WHEREAS**, the club made contributions to disaster victims and
27 helped establish an orphanage in the Philippines; and

28 **WHEREAS**, EASGC also provided monetary support to fund
29 scholarships for deserving students at the University of Guam; and

30 **WHEREAS**, the past presidents of the Engineers, Architects and
31 Surveyors Club: Mr. Ed Hipona, Mr. Nars Guertes, Mr. Vic Ovalles, Mr.
32 Efren Tanag, Mr. Rene Alcazaren, Mr. Roger Ruelos, Mr. Art Chan, Mr.
33 Armand Cayand, Mr. Bob Field, Mr. Ted Abella, Mr. Angel Mendoza, Mr.
34 PJ Jose, Mr. Vic Dew Roca, Mr. Rick Unpingco, Mr. Dubel Conlu, Mr.
35 Nemy Macario, Mr. Ding Vales, Mr. Warly Gaid, Mr. Rene H. Ramos, Mr.
36 James Badong and Mr. Enrico Gloton have played a vital role in leading the
37 club over the past twenty (20) years; and

38 **WHEREAS**, the newly elected officers: President-elect Bernie
39 Maranan, Vice President-elect Ben Reyes, Treasurer-elect Pascual Jasa,

40 Secretary-elect Joe Vitug and Auditor-elect Ted Abella will be sworn in on
41 February 11, 2012 and are expected to continue leading EASGC to carry out
42 its mission; and now therefore, be it

44 hereby, on behalf of the People of Guam, commend and congratulate the
45 Engineers, Architects and Surveyors Club for all their years of service to the
