- 5 the Philippines and the United States as well as its territories; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Jose L. Cuisia Jr. was born on July 16, 1944 in Manila,
- 7 Philippines and is married to Maria Victoria Jose Cuisia, whom he has five
- 8 children with; and
- 9 WHEREAS, in 1967, Ambassador Cuisia received his degrees in
- 10 Bachelor of Arts in Social Science and Bachelor of Science in Commerce at De
- 11 La Salle University where he graduated Magna Cum Laude. Furthermore, he
- 12 continued to acquire higher education by attending Wharton School of

- 1 Business at the University of Pennsylvania where he completed his Masters
- 2 Degree in Business Administration—Finance in 1970; and
- 3 WHEREAS, throughout his career, Ambassador Jose L. Cuisia, Jr. was
- 4 awarded numerous monumental awards and recognitions in the Philippines
- 5 and internationally that gave pride to the Philippines and to Filipinos
- 6 worldwide; and
- WHEREAS, his impressive achievements throughout his career include
- 8 being named the Ten Outstanding Young Men (TOYM) Awardee for
- 9 Domestic Banking in 1982, Chief Executive Award for Business Excellence in
- 10 the Philippines, Asian Insurance Personality of the Year and Manuel L.
- 11 Quezon Award for Exemplary Governance. In addition, in 2011, Ambassador
- 12 Jose L. Cuisia Jr., was awarded the Joseph Wharton Award for Lifetime
- 13 Achievement for an outstanding career in the banking and insurance industry;

- WHEREAS, Ambassador Cuisia has held various executive positions in
- some of the most prestigious companies in the Philippines with his expertise
- 17 in the banking and insurance industries. Other positions he held include,
- 18 Central Bank governor, chairman of the Monetary Board and chairman of the
- 19 Philippine Deposit Insurance Corporation (PDIC) Board. In addition, he was
- 20 also president and CEO of the Social Security System (SSS) and director of the
- 21 Philippine National Bank (PNB); and

WHEREAS, he also posses exemplary skills in the managerial field 1 2 where he took higher positions in prestigious corporations across the 3 Philippines. He served as the director of Far East Bank and Trust Company, Vice Chairman of SM Prime Holdings. He also served as a member of the 4 5 company's Nominating Committee and Chairman of the Audit and Risk Management Committee. In addition, he took the position of director for 6 7 Holcim Philippines Inc., and Bacnotan Consolidated Industries; and 8 WHEREAS, one of his most recent achievements was acquiring the 9 nomination as the Philippine Ambassador to the United States from the 10 Philippine President Benigno Aquino III in 2010.
