3 **WHEREAS,** Carmelita Mae Borja Calvo is a 1978 graduate of Sunnyvale High
4 School, Sunnyvale, California and after graduating from high school; on April 18,
5 1979, she enlisted in the Guam Army National Guard and thereafter serving a
6 cumulative thirty three (33) of military service in the U.S. Army, the Army Reserve,
7 and the Guam Army National Guard; and

8 **WHEREAS,** Master Sergeant Carmelita Mae Borja Calvo has served as a
9 Senior NCO in various positions of great responsibility in the Command
10 Administrative Office, the Directorate of Information Management, the Directorate of
11 Human Resources, the Operations and Plans Directorate and was also deployed to

1 Afghanistan with the 1-294 Infantry Regiment in support of Operations Enduring
2 Freedom; and

3 **WHEREAS**, upon her return to Guam from deployment in Afghanistan, Master
4 Sergeant Calvo assumed the duties as the J3 Training Noncommissioned Officer and
5 then was subsequently reassigned to her current position as the Operations NCO of the
6 J3 Directorate of Operations and Plans in the Guam Army National Guard. As the
7 Operations NCO, Master Sergeant Calvo interacted with various federal and local
8 agencies external to the Guam National Guard and planned and coordinated multiple
9 Community Support missions; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Master Sergeant Calvo's education include the following: 1979
11 attended the Power Generator & Light Wheel Vehicle Mechanic, Fort Jackson, South
12 Carolina; in 1986 attended the Primary Leadership Development Course, Schofield
13 Barracks, Hawaii; in 1989 attended the Basic Noncommissioned Officer Course, Fort
14 Benjamin Harrison, Indiana; in 1990 attended the Inspector General Course, Fort
15 Belvoir, Virginia; in 1992 attended the Advance Noncommissioned Officer Course,
16 Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana; in 1999 attended the Personnel Service Specialist,
17 Kansas; in 2002 attended the Vincennes University, (43 Semester Hours); in 2010
18 attended the Battle Staff NCO, Phase 1; followed by the First Sergeant Course, Phase
19 1; and other numerous courses from Federal Emergency Management Agency; and

20 **WHEREAS**, throughout Master Sergeant Calvo's thirty three (33) years of
21 military service in the U.S. Army, the Army Reserve, and the Guam Army National

27 October 1984 – May 1985, Litter Bearer, 838th Medical Company, Fort Juan Muna,

1 Guam; May 1985 – July 1987, Clerk Typist, Plans, Operations, and Training Division,
2 Fort Juan Muna, Guam; July 1987 – January 1992, Executive Administrative
3 Assistant, Command Administrative Office, Fort Juan Muna, Guam; January 1992 –
4 November 1998, Administrative Noncommissioned Officer, Directorate of
5 Information Management, Fort Juan Muna, Guam; November 1998 – April 2004,
6 Personnel Noncommissioned Officer, Active Guard Reserve Human Resource
7 Manager Office, Tiyan, Guam; April 2004 – November 2007, Senior Personnel
8 Service Noncommissioned Officer, Directorate of Personnel & Human Resources,
9 Barrigada, Guam; November 2007 – December 2008, Senior Operations
10 Noncommissioned Officer, 1-294th Infantry Regiment, Afghanistan; December 2008
11 – April 2010, Training Noncommissioned Officer, Directorate of Plans & Operations,
12 Barrigada, Guam; April 2010 – Present, Operations Noncommissioned Officer,
13 Directorate of Plans & Operations, Barrigada, Guam; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Master Sergeant Calvo's military awards and decorations include:

16 (2nd Award); the Army Commendation Medal (7th Award); the Army Achievement

18 Achievement Medal; the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal; the Humanitarian
19 Service Medal (2nd Award); the Noncommissioned Officer Professional Development
20 Ribbon (3rd Award); the Army Service Ribbon; the Overseas Service Ribbon; the
21 Armed Forces Reserve Medal (*with* M Device); the Military Outstanding Volunteer
22 Service Medal; the NATO Medal; and the Armed Forces Reserve Medal; now
