BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

- 1 WHEREAS, on October 1, 1962, President John F. Kennedy signed into law
- legislation that designated the 15th of May, every year, as a special day to honor Peace 2
- Officers in communities nationwide, for their commitment and service in the 3
- protection of citizens from criminal activities, especially extreme violence and 4
- 5 terrorism; and
- WHEREAS, on this special day set aside to honor Peace Officers, Guam joins 6
- 7 communities throughout the nation in paying honor and recognition to the courageous
- 8 men and women who keep enforcing the laws, protecting citizens from injustice, and
- providing public safety services for all of Guam's people; and 9

WHEREAS, every single day, Peace Officers throughout the island are asked to place themselves in harm's way to protect the community and to provide for the public's safety, and at times this may require that they risk their lives and pay the ultimate sacrifice, which is at a tremendous cost to the community, but also a valuable service in the protection of our island and its people; and WHEREAS, the people of Guam will observe "Peace Officer's Memorial Day" on May 15, 2012, which is a time to acknowledge the brave men and women in uniform who have paid the ultimate sacrifice while serving in the line of duty, and have given of their lives in the protection of life and property for the people of Guam; and WHEREAS, the following individuals have served as Peace Officers for the people of Guam, and have given of their lives: Police Sergeant Frankie E.
