WHEREAS, Senator Teofisto Guingona III or "TG," as he is known to friends and colleagues, comes from a long line of public servants and is currently a senator of the 15th Congress of the Republic of the Philippines (2010-2016); and

WHEREAS, TG served as Congressman of the Second District of Bukidnon during the 13th and 14th Congress. In the Lower House, he was a member of the opposition and the minority group. He is the Deputy Minority floor leader and is the Minority representative to the Joint Congressional Power Commission (POWERCOM), which deals with matters relating to energy and electricity; and

WHEREAS, TG is a lawyer and graduated from the Ateneo de Manila University with a degree in Economics and Law. This is where he met his wife, Atty. Maria Victoria Garcia Guingona and together they have a son, Bobby; and

WHEREAS, while in college, he experienced his first taste of politics when he joined the student government. TG, along with his colleagues in the student government joined a protest rally of the opposition party Lakas ng Bayan (LABAN) to protest the cheating by the dictator Ferdinand Marcos during the 1978 elections. While marching along España Avenue in Manila, TG and the entire Ateneo student government were arrested; and

WHEREAS, from his youth in the Ateneo student government up until this day, TG still strongly believes in the principles of transparency in governance and accountability of government officials. Because of this, TG was chosen as a Kaya Natin! Champion as part of a national movement in the Philippines that aims to promote good governance, ethical leadership and support effective and ethical leaders in government; and

WHEREAS, Senator Guingona has set the objective of his legislative work to ensure that the government invests in the Filipino people. To TG, investing in the Filipino people means using national resources to build a healthy and educated citizenry. He seeks to protect the most vulnerable segments of the population and make certain that they are neither impoverished materially nor marginalized socially. His efforts also try to foster the investment climate necessary to create job opportunities that will enable greater human and not just economic, development. To achieve these objectives, Senator Guingona has set budget reform at the center of his legislative agenda; and

WHEREAS, Senator Guingona also seeks to craft legislation that will ensure both energy and food security through the use of more local resources. By doing this, he aims to make the price of food and energy both affordable and predictable to make more money available for families to educate their children and take care of their health needs; and
