3           **WHEREAS**, Jackalyne Pfannenstiel was appointed Assistant Secretary of the Navy  
4 (Energy, Installations and Environment) on March 5, 2010; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Secretary Pfannenstiel was responsible for formulating department-wide  
6 policies, procedures, advocacy and strategic plans, as well as overseeing all Department of the  
7 Navy functions and programs related to installations, safety, energy and environment; and

8           **WHEREAS**, in the course of these complex and multiple duties, Secretary Pfannenstiel  
9 was responsible in large measure for implementing the U.S. – Japan agreement to realign U.S.  
10 forces in Japan and relocate five thousand (5000) Marines and their families from Okinawa to  
11 Guam; and the development of the department's energy strategy, policies and guidance; and

12           **WHEREAS**, in the course of her duties, Secretary Pfannenstiel has proven to be an  
13 exceptional leader, sensitive to the concerns expressed by the leadership and citizenry of Guam  
14 concerning the Guam Military Buildup/Pacific Realignment; and

15           **WHEREAS**, Secretary Pfannenstiel has demonstrated both patience and understanding  
16 of the advocates of Guam, balancing these concerns with those of the Department of Defense as  
17 we moved through the challenges and planning for the buildup; now, therefore, be it

2 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam does hereby, recognize and commend Assistant  
3 Secretary of the Navy, Jackalyne Pfannenstiel, for her many accomplishments and distinguished  
4 service to the people of Guam, the United States Navy and her country and does further extend  
5 *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse* to her; and be it further
