- WHEREAS, Brian Pak was born on February 4, 1966 and is married to 3

- WHEREAS, Pak earned his Bachelor's Degree in engineering from the 5
- University of California, Davis; and 6
- WHEREAS, when Pak was growing up, he dreamt of being a CEO of a 7
- large corporation; and 8
- WHEREAS, this dream led him to start his own company in 1993 called 9
- Intercontinental Management Consultants Inc., which did consulting for 10
- 11 construction and project management, operated a bus and tour company, and
- 12 employed about seventy (70) workers; and
- WHEREAS, in 1999, Pak stopped the operation of his company after nearly 13
- 14 eight (8) years of business to be able to spend more time with his family; and

- WHEREAS, after taking some time off to be with his family, Pak was contacted by his friend Charles "Chuck" Abbott who was the then General Manager of the Westin Resort Guam; and
- WHEREAS, Pak began his career in the hotel industry as the sales and revenue manager for Westin Resort Guam; and
- WHEREAS, after four (4) years with the Westin, Pak was transferred to W
 Hotels Seoul in South Korea as part of its opening team; and
- WHEREAS, his work at W Hotels Seoul led him to the Ken Corp. Group,
 where he currently holds the seat as Vice President; and
- 10 **WHEREAS,** through Ken Corp., Pak was assigned to the Aqua Resort Club 11 in Saipan where he served as General Manager for ten (10) months before 12 returning to Guam; and
- WHEREAS, for serving six years(6) in the Ken Corp. Hotel Operation and Management, Pak was elected as one of the four ,Managing Directors to oversee all 7 hotels and 1 golf course in the Micronesia area; and
- WHEREAS, Pak also managed the Hotel Santa Fe and the then-Palace
 Hotel; Pak remained at the Palace after the Hotel Santa Fe was sold and
- WHEREAS, in November 2006, the Palace closed to undergo a major renovation and rebranding with Pak leading the hotel's renovation team, opening the Sheraton Laguna Guam Resort in April 2007; and
- WHEREAS, in 2009, Pak was asked to take over as the Managing Director of the Country Club of the Pacific Golf Course (CCP);
- WHEREAS, Pak's role at the CCP was to oversee operations and to provide a direction for success, leading CCP to be looked at as one of the premier golf courses in Guam and the Marianas; and
