**Relative to recognizing Mr. Brian Pak for his outstanding service and contribution as the General Manager for the Sheraton Laguna Guam Resort.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'***  
2           ***TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS,** Brian Pak was born on February 4, 1966 and is married to  
4           Cammie Pak, whom they have a son, Christopher, 21; and

5           **WHEREAS,** Pak earned his Bachelor's Degree in engineering from the  
6           University of California, Davis; and

7           **WHEREAS,** when Pak was growing up, he dreamt of being a CEO of a  
8           large corporation; and

9           **WHEREAS,** this dream led him to start his own company in 1993 called  
10          Intercontinental Management Consultants Inc., which did consulting for  
11          construction and project management, operated a bus and tour company, and  
12          employed about seventy (70) workers; and

13          **WHEREAS,** in 1999, Pak stopped the operation of his company after nearly  
14          eight (8) years of business to be able to spend more time with his family; and

1           **WHEREAS**, after taking some time off to be with his family, Pak was  
2 contacted by his friend Charles “Chuck” Abbott who was the then General  
3 Manager of the Westin Resort Guam; and

4           **WHEREAS**, Pak began his career in the hotel industry as the sales and  
5 revenue manager for Westin Resort Guam; and

6           **WHEREAS**, after four (4) years with the Westin, Pak was transferred to W  
7 Hotels Seoul in South Korea as part of its opening team; and

8           **WHEREAS**, his work at W Hotels Seoul led him to the Ken Corp. Group,  
9 where he currently holds the seat as Vice President; and

10          **WHEREAS**, through Ken Corp., Pak was assigned to the Aqua Resort Club  
11 in Saipan where he served as General Manager for ten (10) months before  
12 returning to Guam; and

13          **WHEREAS**, for serving six years(6) in the Ken Corp. Hotel Operation and  
14 Management, Pak was elected as one of the four ,Managing Directors to oversee  
15 all 7 hotels and 1 golf course in the Micronesia area; and

16          **WHEREAS**, Pak also managed the Hotel Santa Fe and the then-Palace  
17 Hotel; Pak remained at the Palace after the Hotel Santa Fe was sold and

18          **WHEREAS**, in November 2006, the Palace closed to undergo a major  
19 renovation and rebranding with Pak leading the hotel’s renovation team, opening  
20 the Sheraton Laguna Guam Resort in April 2007; and

21          **WHEREAS**, in 2009, Pak was asked to take over as the Managing Director  
22 of the Country Club of the Pacific Golf Course (CCP);

23          **WHEREAS**, Pak’s role at the CCP was to oversee operations and to provide  
24 a direction for success, leading CCP to be looked at as one of the premier golf  
25 courses in Guam and the Marianas; and

1           **WHEREAS**, outside of work, Pak enjoys spending time with his family,  
2 playing golf, his newfound hobby tennis, and also enjoys playing with his Cavalier  
3 King Charles Spaniard named Charlie; now, therefore be it;

4           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina' Trentai Unu Na*  
5 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam recognize Mr.  
6 Brian Pak for his outstanding service and contribution as the General Manager for  
7 the Sheraton Laguna Guam Resort; and would like to extend best wishes to Mr.  
8 Pak on his new career opportunity; and be it further

9           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on
