3 WHEREAS, Mr. Joseph Taimanglo Afaisen is married to Bertha L. Castro, and  
4 both are the parents of Joshua Lee (married to Savanna Gleason), Natasha Jo (married  
5 to Eric Dela Cruz), Sheeka Jo (married to Jacob Tareyama), Shayna Jo, and Joseph Jr.;

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Joseph Taimanglo Afaisen graduated from the University of  
8 Guam in 1984 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in General Social Science, with an  
9 emphasis in Psychology and Sociology. He also proudly served a combined six (6) years  
10 as an active and then reserve member of the U.S. Army (E-6 Staff Sergeant); and

11           **WHEREAS**, In 1984, Mr. Joseph Taimanglo Afaisen began his career as a  
12 Correction Social Worker for the Department of Corrections. Mr. Afaisen was promoted  
13 in 2005 to serve as the Administrator of the Casework & Counseling Services Division;

15           **WHEREAS**, throughout his career, Mr. Joseph Taimanglo Afaisen received  
16 numerous recognitions and citations. Notably, Mr. Afaisen was presented with the  
17 “Valor Award” for bravery and ability for rendering life saving service which was  
18 presented by former Senator Doris F. Brooks in 1990. Mr. Afaisen also earned the  
19 Governor’s MagPro 2011 “Administrator of the Year” Award and was selected  
20 “Veteran of the Year” in 2011 representing the village of Inarajan; and

21           **WHEREAS**, as Mr. Joseph Taimanglo Afaisen is a resident of Inarajan and an  
22 active parishioner of the St. Joseph Catholic Church in Inarajan. Mr. Afaisen is actively  
23 engaged in different community and religious organizations as he is a member of the  
24 Pastoral Counsel, Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist, Teacher for the Pre-  
25 Confirmation, Confirmation, and Rite of Christian Initiation for Adult (RCIA), and is  
26 also a member of the Guam Cursillo Movement Ministry. Mr. Afaisen also became the  
27 Grand Marshal for the St. Joseph Annual Fiesta 2012; now, therefore be it
