3 WHEREAS, Jeneé M. Barnett was born in Fresno, California and grew up in
4 Huron, California; and

5 WHEREAS, Jeneé M. Barnett has been married to her husband of twenty-two
6 (22) years, Richard Barnett (LCDR) and they have two sons, Austin and Tyler

7 WHEREAS, Jeneé M. Barnett received an AA in Liberal Arts from West Hills
8 Community College, a BBA from Fresno State University, and her Masters of Arts in
9 Elementary Teacher Education from the University of Phoenix; and

10 WHEREAS, Jeneé M. Barnett has worked for DODEA and has volunteered in
11 multiple youth sports events, and has created communities off and on base since she
12 arrived on Guam in 2004; and

13 WHEREAS, Jeneé M. Barnett developed the Naval Base Guam Branch of NAYS
14 (National Alliance Youth Sports Program); and

15 WHEREAS, Jeneé M. Barnett tripled opportunities for youth during summer
16 fitness and summer clinics, and generated new revenue with the implementation of
17 dance gear resale items; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Jeneé M. Barnett developed a partnership with DoDea elementary
2 and middle schools to implement an annual sports day for over 800 children; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Jeneé M. Barnett spearheaded the training and facilitation of the
4 micros RecTrac computer system resulting in easier registration and tracking for youth
5 programs; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Jeneé M. Barnett served as the Child Youth Program Director &
7 Contracting Officer's Representative for MWR Guam from July 2010 through July 2012;
8 and

9 **WHEREAS**, Jeneé M. Barnett leaves us after 8 long years to Great Lakes Chicago
10 as her husband reports to his duty station; now, therefore be it
