3 WHEREAS, on Saturday, August 25, 2012, from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm, the
4 *Serve Guåhan!* Commission will be hosting the Fourth Annual Guam Volunteer
5 Center Conference, at the Guam Marriott Resort and Spa, Chamorro Ballroom, The
6 *Serve Guam!* Commission is working to strengthen and promote volunteer service
7 opportunities for Guam residents of all ages and background; and

8 WHEREAS, the Volunteer Center Conference will highlight the seven
9 strategic initiatives of the Government of Guam promulgated by Governor Edward JB
10 Calvo which includes the following: Education; Energy / Environment; Healthy
11 Futures; Homeland Security; Veterans and Military Families; Economic
12 Opportunities; and Capacity Building and volunteerism in Service; and

1 **WHEREAS**, since its inception, the *Serve Guåhan!* Commission strongly
2 believes that service is a hallmark of our peoples' character, and throughout our
3 history our people have always stepped up to meet the challenges by volunteering in
4 their communities; and

5 **WHEREAS**, since its establishment, the Governor's Guahan Volunteer Center

7 difference in our island community by inspiring service alumni, and to continue their
8 program mission to serve our island in partnership with community organizations; and

11 principles, such as: *service* as a solution in identifying and targeting resources to
12 tackle issues; *expand opportunities* to serve our citizens and provide access to service
