- WHEREAS, Mrs. Flor Martinez was born on July 5, 1959 in Manila,
- 4 Philippines and her parents were Fortunato and Laura Bathan; and
- WHEREAS, she has been married to Mario Martinez since 1985, to whom
- 6 she has a son, Nathaniel Mark Martinez; and
- WHEREAS, in 1981, she acquired her degree of Doctor of Dental Medicine
- 8 in De Ocampo Memorial College in Manila, Philippines and later took and passed
- 9 the Philippine Dental Board Examination in December 1981. In 1982, she enrolled
- to a Post Graduate Course at Philippine General Hospital for Oral Surgery; and
- WHEREAS, on May, 1982, she migrated to Guam and was first employed
- at the Department of Public Health and Social Services with a temporary position
- in the Dental Section under AHRD for nine (9) months; and

WHEREAS, after leaving DPHSS, Mrs. Martinez was employed at the Private Clinic as Dental Hygienist for 4 months, and in October 3, 1983, she was rehired and employed at DPHSS for permanent position as Dental Health Specialist I and worked at Inarajan Public Health Dental Section for 2 years; and

WHEREAS, during her employment, she prepared all fields of operation for the dentists by setting out the instruments and supplies that would be needed in the treatment of the patients, assisted dentists in dental procedures, provided safety measures to protect the patients, dentists and public from potential contaminants, ensured accuracy of patient information, tested patient for hypertension and diabetes to confirm that they are cleared for dental procedures, and educated patients on proper oral hygiene practices and taking their medications as prescribed by their physician or dentist; and

WHEREAS, In 1985 to 1994, she was transferred to Central Public Health Dental Section with a full staff clinic operation of 6 dentists, 16 dental assistant, 4 dental receptionists, and in 1988, she was promoted to Dental Health Specialist II; and

WHEREAS, In 1994, she was sent to Palau Community College to attend schooling for Dental Health Advocate Instructor Training Program, which was sponsored by the Pacific Island Health Officers Association, with the University of Kentucky Instructor and Workshop Directors, Dr. Ralph Frew, Dr. Raynor Mullins, and Dr. David Hardison; and

WHEREAS, in 1995, she was moved to work to Northern Region Community Health Center Dental Clinic in Dededo and was again promoted to Dental Health Specialist III. In 1996, she was moved back to Central Public Health until retirement on Sept. 28, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Martinez had also conducted and attended various presentations as in August 1995, she attended the International Dental Symposium, presenting "Review of Endodontic Principles of General Dentistry", made a presentation in Dental Hygiene at George Washington High School in 1997, and in May 2011, she attended the Asia Pacific Dental Conference in the Philippine International Convention Center, Manila Philippines, and in February 2012, the dental staff was invited to give dental presentation in celebration of Dental Health Month in some public elementary schools; and 

WHEREAS, Mrs. Flor Martinez excelled in her service as she was given a certificate of Achievement in Recognition of Outstanding Performance and Evaluation and another certificate of recognition for participating in the "National Children Health Fair" sponsored by the Guam Dental Society and the Department of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, she has showed dedicated community service by volunteering in giving invaluable time by helping the DPHSS Food Stamp Program Process food stamp during time of emergencies caused by natural disasters like: Super typhoon OMAR 1992, Super typhoon PAKA 1997, and Chata'an 2002;; and

WHEREAS, In 2004, she was involved in the Guam Fluoride Varnish Program which the dental staff applied fluoride varnish to children five years and younger to prevent dental caries, visited various Headstart centers, located in 20 elementary school throughout the Island, visited daycares; participated in Immunization Outreach with the nursing staff and attended health fair at the mall to apply fluoride varnish to children; and

WHEREAS, She has participated in various projects like the 2007 Island Wide Immunization Survey, Homeless Coalition Survey in 2008 and 2011, H1N1 Mass Vaccinations that were held in various locations all over the island to ensure

- that the people were protected from the H1N1 Virus and participated in the 2009
- 2 Homeless Point in Count, where volunteers tried to count the number of homeless
- 3 people on the island; and
- WHEREAS, her dedicated and committed service to our island community
- 5 has benefited the people of Guam in various ways during her thirty (30) years of
