- WHEREAS, in October 2012, Guam is proud to host the 20<sup>th</sup> Convention of the
- 4 Federation of Asia-Pacific Women's Association (FAWA); and
- WHEREAS, it is FAWA's mission to promote closer relations, and bring about joint
- 6 efforts among the Asian-Pacific communities, particularly among women, through mutual
- 7 appreciation of cultural, moral and socio-economic value; and
- 8 WHEREAS, FAWA's motto is "Asian Women United for Service", and their objectives
- 9 are to foster friendship and understanding, and to develop mutual cooperation among the Asia-
- Pacific women; to understand their philosophy and values, and to encourage cultural ties among
- the Asia-Pacific countries; to work towards a better life for the Asia-Pacific region; and to strive
- 12 for peace; and
- WHEREAS, the Federation of Asia-Pacific Women's Association was founded in 1959,
- by distinguished international women with the highest academic backgrounds; and

WHEREAS, these women were products of the best universities in the world, and a

2 number of them were members of the Parliament of their respective countries, if not the officers

- 3 of prestigious world women organizations; and
- 4 WHEREAS, FAWA consists of organizations from the Philippines, Taiwan, Japan,
- 5 Singapore, Korea, and Guam;
- 6 WHEREAS, on Guam there are eight (8) FAWA member organizations which include
- 7 the Guam Women's Club (a charter member club of FAWA), the Guam Council of Women's
- 8 Clubs, the American Association of University Women Guam Chapter, the Chinese Ladies
- 9 Association of Guam, the Filipino Ladies Association of Guam, the International Women's Club
- of Guam, Soroptimist International of Guam and Soroptimist International of the Marianas; and
- WHEREAS, Charter Members included: Burma Union of Burma Council of Women's
- Associations; Guam Guam Women's Club; Laos Lao Women's Association; Singapore -
- 13 Federation of Girls Clubs (now Singapore Women's Association); the Republic of China Taipei
- 14 International Women's Club, Chinese Women, Anti-Aggression League, and YWCA; Thailand -
- 15 Thai Culture Women's Club; Vietnam International Women's Association; and the Philippines
- National Federation of Women's Clubs; and
- WHEREAS, Guam was a charter member nation of FAWA and Congresswoman
- 18 Madeleine Z. Bordallo's signature is on the official charter; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Bordallo served as President of FAWA in 1998, which
- 20 was the last time the FAWA convention was held in Guam; and
- 21 **WHEREAS,** the FAWA convention is held every two years and hosting rotates between
- member nations. It has been held on Guam four times in 1964, 1978, 1990, and 1998; and

WHEREAS, the FAWA Board consists of representatives from the FAWA member

- 2 nations, and those from Guam include Honorary President, Congresswoman Madeleine Z.
- 3 Bordallo, President, Kristal Koga, Secretary, Dr. Rebecca Stephenson, Treasurer Chet Neri, and
- 4 Programme Chair, Lulu Chen; and
