3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf has devoted 33 years to
4 education, civic leadership, and continuous personal and professional development;
5 and,

6 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf, over the course of three decades
7 has contributed a lifetime of service of teaching, leading, and serving others in order
8 that the youth and families of Guam may grow and prosper and in doing so has further
9 enriched his community and the organizations of which he was a member to; and,

10 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf is of Chamoru descent, is one of
11 twelve children, was born on Guam to Francisco P. and Ana P. Chargualaf, raised in
12 *Inalahan, Guahan*, is married to Janice Ranae Anderson Chargualaf, has six beautiful
13 children, and now resides in Windward Hills, Yona; and,

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf is a scholar-leader whose record
2 of formal and continuing education is evidence of his commitment to higher
3 education, reflective thought, and action research; and,

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf is a scholar-leader who, after
5 graduating from George Washington High School, went on to attain a Masters of
6 Education degree in School Administration and Supervision after completing a
7 Bachelor of Arts degree in Education; and,

8 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf's attainment of specialized
9 certification in Administration and Supervision as well as Secondary Social Studies
10 and whose extended professional certification and training with the Leadership
11 Academy, National Association School Resource Officer, SAT 10, Federal
12 Emergency Management Institute, in addition to having attended and successfully
13 completing at least 30 other professional development opportunities classifies
14 Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf as a consummate and highly educated teaching and K-12
15 public educational administration professional; and,

16 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf's distinguished career in
17 education spans assignments in teaching in at least four public secondary schools;
18 coordinating, serving as a technical assistant, tutor, or counselor for the Education
19 Summit, LOTE, Learning Audit, Project LEAD, and Upward Bound programs;
20 serving as an educational administrative leader either as a Principal or Assistant
21 Principal in at least eight public secondary schools in addition to having served as
22 Associate Superintendent of Secondary Education; serving as an adjunct instructor at
23 the University of Guam; and as a WASC visiting team member; and,

24 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf's commitment to
25 professionalism, scholarship, and devotion to excelsior performance is further
26 evidenced in the over 15 certificates of recognition and extensive listing of

1 professional achievements some of which include but are not limited to the “Real
2 World Design Challenge, Governor’s Certificate (2011-12),” “Academy for School
3 Executives,” lecturing about “School Finance” (2012), “School Leadership &
4 Administration” (2010), contribution to the 2nd SCOVE Conference, “Vocational
5 Education: School-to-Work, 1994,” “Faithful Service, John F. Kennedy High
6 School;” and for achievements in contributing to the *DOE District Action Plan, 2008-
7 2013*, authoring Guam Department of Education Learning Audit Guidebook (1997),
8 establishing the GDOE Principal Leadership Academy (1992-2012), being nominated
9 for “Outstanding Young Men of America” (1987), Chi Omicron Gamma Recipient
10 (1977 & 1985), having graduated Magna Cum Laude (1979), being named a Merit
11 Award Scholarship Recipient (1975-1979) and President Chiang Kai Shek
12 Scholarship Recipient (1977-1979) and being named to the University of Guam
13 Dean’s List (1975-1979); and,

14 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf’s experiences and
15 accomplishments extend beyond serving as a teacher and educational administrator.
16 Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf has faithfully and extensively served on committees at
17 the school, district, and territorial level, to include the Governor’s Education Task
18 Force, School Leaders Evaluation Committee, Principal’s Leadership Design Team,
19 Professional Teacher Evaluation Program Committee, Budget Committee, Chair,
20 District Action Plan Committee, Varied Board Policy Committees, Impact on Military

22 State of the Education Address Committee, School Finance Committee, SAT10
23 Committee, Austerity Committee, and Service Learning Committee; and,

24 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf has demonstrated that he is a
25 leader in education and in the greater island community. He attained professional,
26 civic, and faith-based memberships. Mr. Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf is a member of

6 Lujan Elementary School Parent Teacher Association (1998-2000), Chairman of the
7 Academy of School Executives, President (1978-1982) and Vice President (1974-
8 1977) of the Inarajan Youth Democratic Party of Guam, and was an Instructor for
9 Catholic Catechism Classes; and,

10 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth Paulino Chargualaf’s generous contribution of his
11 expert knowledge and experience, motivational spirit, and genuine love for his fellow
12 man culminated in his being nominated and named a finalist for the “2011 Governor’s
