WHEREAS, Frank Tedtaotao was born on Guam and whose parents are Robert and Maria Tedtaotao and grew up in the village of Inarajan with his six brothers and sisters. He has seven children named Mike, Jessica, Vanderick, Frankie, Patrick, Manet and Robert and is also blessed with 12 grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, he attended Inarajan Elementary School for grade school and graduated from Inarajan High School in 1972; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Tedtaotao started his career in the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) in 1981 as a Community Program Aide I. In 1986, he switched jobs and became a Maintenance Worker; and

WHEREAS, in 1987, he was asked to take over the duties of the Supply Supervisor who retired due to illness. He agreed to oversee the Supply Section

1 since though he knew that it was a critical position in the department. For his
2 efforts, he was granted a step increase for his exceptional work; and

3 **WHEREAS**, In 1988, he moved on to Supply Clerk and was later promoted to his
4 current position as Inventory Management Officer in the same year. Mr. Tedtaotao
5 supervised and directed overall activities on the inventory management
6 procurement and property control of the department. He planned, developed, and
7 implemented property disposal operations between the various divisions, bureaus
8 and sections of the DPHSS and the General Services Agency (GSA); and

9 **WHEREAS**, he also conducted and maintained the fixed asset inventory of the
10 department and verified the deliveries of equipment and supplies in the
11 department. He prepared survey reports and coordinated the transfer of surveyed
12 items to GSA. He served as the liaison for the Guam Telephone Authority and
13 made sure that telephone services were not disrupted in the department; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Tedtatotao was very professional with his work as he also
15 received numerous Outstanding Performance Evaluations during his thirty-two
16 (32) year career at DPHSS; and

17 **WHEREAS**, having worked thirty (32) years with the Government of
18 Guam, he is a man of experience and will truly be missed by his colleagues from
19 DPHSS. Today, he celebrates his well deserved retirement where he plans to finish
20 renovating his house; and now, be it further
