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Relative to acknowledging, commending and honoring Ms. Margaret A. Bengzon, President and CEO of Guam Healthcare Development, Inc. -- Guam Regional Medical City, for her unique capacity, extraordinary vision and unwavering commitment to improving health care, and reducing the rate of non-communicable diseases in Micronesia by investing in the people of Guam and thereby improving the quality of life for the entire region, and to also celebrate the "Topping off of Ancillary Areas" of the Guam Regional Medical City which took place on Wednesday, Dec. 12, 2012 (12-12-12).

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1           BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I*  
2           *MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

3           **WHEREAS**, The Medical City organization has over forty-five years of  
4           experience in hospital operations and administration, its world-class health care  
5           complex serving some 50,000 in-patients and 1.2 million out-patients annually,  
6           with a medical staff of 1,500 physicians who are established experts in their  
7           various fields of specialization, and who are assisted by a staff of over 2,200  
8           professionals engaged in allied medical, administrative and support services; and

9           **WHEREAS**, Margaret A. Bengzon serves as a member of The Medical City's  
10          senior management, overseeing such critical units as Human Resources,  
11          Information Technology, Systems and Quality, Marketing and Sales, Customer  
12          Relations, Corporate Communications and Corporate Planning; and

1           **WHEREAS**, She led the hospital’s bid for the prestigious Joint Commission  
2 International Accreditation in 2006, 2009 and again in 2012, and Ms. Bengzon also  
3 directed the hospital’s Process Reengineering and Organizational Transformation  
4 Project, which positioned the hospital for national and international sector  
5 leadership; and

6           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Bengzon has been responsible for a number of successful  
7 strategic acquisitions and partnerships in the Philippines and abroad, in line with  
8 the hospital’s network development thrust, most recently the Guam Regional  
9 Medical City; and

10           **WHEREAS**, on Wednesday, Dec, 12, 2012, a “Topping off of Ancillary Areas”  
11 ceremony took place to commemorate the event that provides the underpinning  
12 for a bright future for healthcare in Guam; and

13           **WHEREAS**, Because of her unique capacity and extraordinary vision the  
14 people of Guam will no longer have to suffer due to lack of adequate health care  
15 facilities, and

16           **WHEREAS**, The Guam Regional Medical City is not only an important health  
17 care project but also a substantial economic development project that is valued at  
18 over **Two Hundred Sixteen Million Dollars (\$216,000,000)** and will employ over  
19 four hundred staff members; and

20           **WHEREAS**, present at the “Topping off of Ancillary Areas” were the  
21 members of the Board of Directors of Professional Services, Inc (The Medical City)  
22 including President and CEO of The Medical City Dr. Alfredo R.A. Bengzon;
