1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF**

2 ***I MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, in 1997, Attorney Patrick Wolff attended the Catholic Men's
4 Conference in Cincinnati, where the movement started, and which was modeled

1 from an organized group of Protestant men called the “Promise Keepers,” who had
2 a common interest in cultivating their religious beliefs; and

3 **WHEREAS**, this movement had inspired Mr. Wolff to bring the same
4 concept to Guam for men of different ages who share a common interest in
5 cultivating their relationship with God, and serve as a brotherhood in helping each
6 other fulfill the purpose planned for them by God. Mr. Wolff shared this idea with
7 his community and worked with Mr. Charles “Chuck” White to establish this
8 gathering; and

9 **WHEREAS**, their collaboration and the support of the Catholic Church on
10 Guam allowed them to successfully begin the planning, and to eventually
11 commence holding the first (1st) Catholic Men’s Conference in 1999; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the Catholic Men’s Conference is envisioned to be a place to
13 resolve questions of faith by the men of our community who experience some of
14 the same challenges as husbands, sons, and brothers. In fellowship with men from
15 different parishes and villages, the participants realize that they are not alone, but
16 instead, they are a part of a community, but most especially, a part of the Church.
17 During the Catholic Men’s Conference, the men find empathy and camaraderie for
18 the journey, and caring fellowship leads to mutual accountability for the walk of
19 faith; and

20 **WHEREAS**, this year marks the Tenth (10th) Catholic Men’s Conference
21 with the theme of: “MANHOOD of JESUS.” The Conference affords ample
22 opportunity to sing songs of praise, share conversation in small groups, listen to
23 testimonials of faith, and listen to talks on topics of interest to men; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the Catholic Men’s Conference does not only serve as a group
25 for men within the Church, but it is also a tool used to inspire and motivate
26 brothers of our community to come back and reunite with the Catholic faith


1 through the help of these men who share some of the struggles and challenges
2 faced in their daily lives; now therefore, be it

3 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
4 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
5 people of Guam, recognize and commend the Archdiocese of *Agaña* for organizing
6 the Tenth (10th) Catholic Men's Conference; and does further extend a warm *Un*
7 *Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to the organizers for gathering the men of our
8 island community sharing the same purpose; and be it further

9 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on
10 Rules certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that
11 copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the Most Reverend Anthony
12 Apuron, OFM CAP., D.D.; to Reverend Father Paul Gofigan; to Reverend Father
