Relative to commending and congratulating George Washington High School on the 50th anniversary of its Mangilao campus.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I*MINA'TRENTAI KUÅTTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

- WHEREAS, George Washington High School current Mangilao campus was built in 1967; and
- WHEREAS, in 2017 the school marks 50 years at its current campus location and is one of Guam's oldest public high school institutions with a population of over 2,500 students; and
- WHEREAS, the roots of school date back to 1936 when eight classrooms were constructed in pre-war Agaña. The first principal was Mrs. Agueda Iglesias Johnston who presided over 500 junior and senior high school students; and
- WHEREAS, during the wartime bombardment of Agaña by U.S. Forces, the school was reduced to rubble. It was rebuilt in November 1944, four months

- after Guam's liberation. Enrollment steadily increased over the years with students 13 attending from Guam, the mainland and surrounding islands and territories. In 14 1950, the school was moved to the former 5th Marine Depot in Mongmong; and 15 WHEREAS, Typhoon Karen destroyed the Mongmong campus on Nov. 11, 16 1962 and students endured double sessions at Tumon High School, now known as 17 John F. Kennedy High School. Double sessions continued until the current 18 Mangilao campus was completed in 1966. The first class graduated in 1967; and 19 WHEREAS, prominent alumni of the school include District Chief Judge 20 Frances Tydingco-Gatewood, Lt. Gov. Ray Tenorio and Guam Delegate 21 22 Madeleine Z. Bordallo and many, many more; and WHEREAS, the school's administration and faculty have demonstrated 23
 - immense forbearance with the age and condition of the 50-year-old campus and continue to serve students with dedication and determination throughout the years; and

- WHEREAS, the school's alumni will gather in August 2017 for an "every graduating class ever" reunion to celebrate the long history of the school and its community; now, therefore, be it
