- 3 WHEREAS, Community First Guam Federal Credit Union was established on
- 4 May 31, 1962. The original charter members include W.G. Carter, J.T. Perez, Ethel M.
- 5 Riddle, F.O. Loiselle, J.N. Gilbert, Jr., Marilyn H. Tays, J.E. Pearson, F.K. Katterman,
- 6 P.H. Coulter, and Pedro D. Perez; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Community First Guam Federal Credit Union is the oldest local
- 8 Credit Union on Guam. It was formerly known as NavMar Federal Credit Union. The
- 9 Credit Union initially served our Armed Forces such as the Navy, Marines, Coast Guard
- 10 and the Civil Service community on island; and
- WHEREAS, the first location was opened within Naval Station Guam. Today
- there are currently three locations, Hagatna, Tamuning, and Dededo. There are currently
- 13 seventy-three (73) employees with the company; and

1	WHEREAS, in 1962, a small group of men and women formed NavMar Credit
2	Union, a financial cooperative with the goal of providing a safe place to deposit their
3	savings and a fair and honest place to obtain credit; and
4	WHEREAS, in the 1980's, a satellite branch opened its doors in NCTMS to
5	serve members on that base and by the mid 1990's its first off base branch was built in
6	Agana; and
7	WHEREAS, in September 1997, NavMar Credit Union amended its charter to a
8	community status and opened membership to any person living, working, worshipping,
9	or receiving an education on Guam; and
10	WHEREAS, through September 2000, the Credit Union closed its military
11	branches to consolidate operations at its main branch in Hagatna and eventually opened
12	a northern branch in Dededo; and
13	WHEREAS, on October 1, 2000, the Credit Union officially changed its name
14	to Community First Guam Federal Credit Union to better reflect its community charter
15	status; and
16	WHEREAS, today, Community First Guam Federal Credit Union serves a
17	growing member base of more that eleven thousand (11,000) members island wide,
18	made up of diverse backgrounds, professions, and financial needs; and
19	WHEREAS, Community First Guam Federal Credit Union is a full service
20	financial institution that serves as a primary financial resource for thousands of people
21	residing on Guam as well as off-island. Community First Guam FCU's unique approach
22	of providing personal financial solutions based on the individual needs of its members
23	has set the credit union apart from other local financial service offerings; and
