BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA TRENTAJ KUATTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN*:

**WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jaime D.S. Paulino was born on December 8, 1935; and he is the son of Jesus Diego Paulino and Josefina Meno Paulino; and **WHEREAS**, Commissioner Paulino graduated from George Washington Senior High School in 1955; and he then enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1956, and attended Long Beach City College in Long Beach, California, as part of his training. He served honorably in the Vietnam War and retired at the rank of Chief Petty Officer in 1976; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Paulino was a well-regarded and well-respected community member and leader in the villages of Inarajan and Maligay, and he had also extended his services across the island; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Paulino dedicated his post-military career to serving the Government of Guam in various capacities from 1976 to 1997, most notably as the Commissioner (Mayor) of Inarajan, from 1980 to 1988; and he had served as President of the Mayors Council of Guam in 1988. He also served as the Veterans Affairs Coordinator at the University of Guam; as a Senior Investigator in the Office of the *Surobunan*, as a Staff Assistant in the Guam Legislature; as the Vice Chairman of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority Board of Directors; and was also a member of several other boards and commissions under Governor Ricardo J. Bordallo; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Paulino was a lifelong advocate of the Democratic Party; and he spent many years serving on the Central Executive Committee of the Democratic Party of Guam as the Inarajan Representative. He served as the Vice Chairman of the Democratic Party from 2008 to 2012, under then Chairwoman and former Senator Pilar C. Lujan; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Paulino represented the Democratic Party of Guam as a Super Delegate to the 2008 Democratic National Convention, pledging his support for then-Senator Barack Obama; and

**WHEREAS**, following his term as Commissioner (Mayor), the late Honorable Jaime Paulino worked as a close advisor of Governor Ricardo J. Bordallo; and he also served as a long-time aide to the late Senator Herminia Dueñas Dierking; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Paulino was six (6) years old at the start of the Japanese occupation of Guam. As a war survivor who lived a long life after the occupation, he was recognized by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo as symbolizing the strength and perseverance of Guam's people. In 2014, Governor Calvo appointed Commissioner Paulino, who at the time was seventy-seven (77), to serve as Grand Marshal of the Seventieth (70<sup>th</sup>) Anniversary Liberation Day Parade, which was fittingly themed, "Generations of Service and Sacrifice;" and

**WHEREAS**, true to his kind-hearted nature, Commissioner Paulino dedicated much of his life and time to various community organizations, including: the Boy Scouts of America in Inarajan, the Young Men's League of Guam; the Knights of Columbus; the Principal Advisory Council for the schools of Inarajan; the Island-Wide Parents and Teachers Organization; the Inarajan Municipal Planning Council; the Guam Employment Service Council; the Southern Community Health Center; and the Holy Name Society; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Paulino continued to support veterans and the military long past his retirement from the U.S. Navy, offering his time and leadership to the Vietnam Veterans Advisory Council, the Fleet Reserve Association, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, the U.S. Navy League, and as an advisor of the University of Guam's Veteran Club; and

**WHEREAS**, as the son of Jesus Diego and Josefina Meno Paulino, Commissioner Paulino was a devoted family man, who was also a brother to seven (7) siblings; the husband of the late Asuncion (Chong) Babauta Jesus Paulino; the father of Jaime D.S. Paulino Jr., Glenn J. Paulino, the late Jesse F. Paulino, Gerald J. Paulino, and Joel J. Paulino; and, he was also blessed with eleven (11) grandchildren and four (4) great-grandchildren; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Paulino showed much love and dedication for his church, St. Joseph's Church in Inarajan, where he served on the Parish Council, and also served as a teacher and Eucharistic Minister; now therefore, be it
