1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS**, the Catholic Daughters of the Americas (CDA) “*Our Lady of*  
4 *Camarin Court No. 2047*” was established through the support of the late Archbishop  
5 Felixberto Flores, and Mrs. Emilia Long on January 19, 1972; and

6           **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam thank the seven (7) original CDA charter  
7 members still with “*Our Lady of Camarin Court No. 2047*” – Josephina Barcinas,  
8 Imelda Gines, Patricia T. Guerrero, the Honorable Madeleine Z. Bordallo, Josefina  
9 McDonald, Rosario S.N. Santos, and Virginia L.T. Unpingco; and

10           **WHEREAS**, at the launch of the organization, the Reverend Monsignor Vicente  
11 T. Martinez was the first Chaplain and Mary Ropp was the first CDA Regent; and

12           **WHEREAS**, the CDA became a success by answering the call of fellowship,  
13 selflessness, and love that represents our Holy Family; and

1           **WHEREAS**, for the last forty-seven (47) years, the Catholic Daughters of the
