Relative to amending Section 6.01(a)(1)(i) of RULE VI-PROCESSING OF BILLS of the Standing Rules of I Mina'Trentai Singko Na Liheslaturan Guahan, relative to establishing a reasonable timeline for the scheduling of a Public Hearing on Bills introduced by Members or Committees.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I 1 2 MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

3 WHEREAS, I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that Public Hearings 4 opportunities to attain the community's perspective on legislation, and thus this is an occasion that must be presented not as a special request by bill sponsors but that as a responsibility of the legislative process; and

WHEREAS, While the current rules establish a policy for the conducting of Public Hearings to take place "no more than" one hundred eighty (180) days from the introduction of the bill, the reality is that legislative terms are short, and thus more expeditious opportunities must exist to assure that all legislation garner the necessary input in a timely manner so that if the substance of the issue is critical, that there is ample time for it to reach a legislative session for further action; and

1 WHEREAS, The public, and not certain agendas or politics, should have a 2 substantial say in the importance of legislation, thus furthering the need for 3 expeditious timelines in holding a hearing on a measure; and 4 WHEREAS, Many times legislation is introduced to address a pressing issue of that period, and while ninety (90) days seems rather lengthy, it is still a more viable 5 6 option in attaining the public's input versus the status quo; and 7 WHEREAS, If a Committee is unable to schedule or coordinate a public 8 hearing on a bill in the ninety (90) day timeline, the bill's sponsor should have the opportunity to conduct such a meeting, and to keep the consistency of Committee 9 10 responsibilities and decorum, with the presence of Committee staff who shall transcribe the report of the hearing appropriately and accordingly; and 11 WHEREAS, Nothing in this resolution mandates that all legislation be referred 12 13 to a session agenda, but rather it establishes a clear policy that respects the input of 14 the community via public hearings; now, therefore be it 15 **RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'trentai Singko Na 16 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people of Guam, amend Section 6.01(a)(1)(i) of RULE VI-PROCESSING OF BILLS of 17 the Standing Rules of the I Mina' Trentai Singko Na Liheslaturan Guåhan to read as 18 19 follows: 20 (i) All bills introduced by a Member or a Committee shall be given a public hearing no more than ninety one hundred eighty (90180) working days 21 22 after the date of the bill's introduction. If the Committee to which the bill has 23 been referred does not hold a public hearing within the ninety one hundred 24 eighty (90180) working day timeline, the Committee Chairperson shall give a reason in writing to the prime sponsor for not holding a public hearing. 25 26 hearing on a bill is not scheduled by the Committee in ninety (90) days from its
