WHEREAS, Patrick Hogan was born and raised in Guam. He graduated from

Guam Community College Vocational High School in 1988 and received his bachelor's degree in radio, television, and film from the Northwestern University in Chicago; and WHEREAS, Patrick returned to Guam and spent three (3) years as a director and producer of local television commercials, promotions, and documentaries for KTGM TV14, which is the local ABC-Fox affiliate station; and WHEREAS, Patrick was then accepted into the prestigious University of Southern California (USC) School of Cinematics Arts Master of Fine Arts (MFA) program for film and television production in Los Angeles, California and has since written and directed several award-winning films; and

WHEREAS, while in the master's program, Patrick wrote and directed his thesis film *The Business Card*, which is an award-winning short that had the distinction of being the first student film ever sold to an airline for in-flight entertainment; and

1 **WHEREAS.** Patrick's feature directorial debut *Pope Dreams* was screened at 2 over twenty-six (26) festivals around the world, won eleven (11) Best Film awards, was picked up for world-wide distribution by Porchlight Entertainment, aired on the 3 4 Lifetime network, and streamed on Amazon and Netflix; and WHEREAS, Patrick's romantic sci-fi short film Virtually has been screened in 5 6 at least fifteen (15) festivals around the world and has won nine (9) awards thus far, of 7 which include four (4) awards for best film and one (1) award for best director; and 8 WHEREAS, Patrick has also worked as a writer in Hollywood and is currently 9 developing scripts for a romantic-thriller, a comedic-action film, and a supernatural 10 television pilot. He has worked with many notable producers, including Wyck Godfrey, 11 producer of the Twilight Series and I, Robot; Paula Wager, producer of Mission Impossible and Jack Reacher; and John Shesack, producer of Air Force One and Before 12 I Fall; and 13 14 WHEREAS, in addition to his work as a writer and director, Patrick is also a highly accomplished sound editor and supervising sound editor. He has more than one 15 16 hundred (100) television shows and movies to his credits.
