WHEREAS, Charles' dream was to work overseas so he became involved with the Peace Corps and worked as a Nutritionist at the National Hospital in Western Samoa where he performed clinical duties from 1985 to 1987; and he worked out of the National Nutrition Center where he additionally conducted a malnutrition clinic, assisted with an island-wide nutrition survey, and taught Nutrition at the Nursing School and for the Dental Assistant programs; and

WHEREAS, in 1989, Charles came to work for the Pacific Basin MCH Resource Center where he served as a Nutrition Consultant for the U.S.-affiliated Pacific islands of Guam, the CNMI, Palau, the Federated States of Micronesia, and the Marshall Islands for seven (7) months; and during that time, he attended a breastfeeding conference in Pohnpei, he translated numerous health education materials into various languages, and he did productions of various medias; and

WHEREAS, during that same year, Charles began a thirty (30) year public service career serving as the Administrator of Nutrition Health Services at the Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS). It came into its own as a DPHSS Bureau in 2003, and during his tenure the staff grew from eighteen (18) to fifty-one (51), and the WIC caseload increased from one thousand five hundred (1,500) to around seven thousand five hundred (7,500) clients. In addition, the Bureau added the Preventive Health and Health Services Block Grant in 2003 when it became a Bureau employing three (3) individuals. The WIC Program has seen a lot of progress in the past thirty-one (31) years since it has expanded its caseload, moving from one (1) to three (3) months the issuance of benefits, the outsourcing of banking services in 1993, the automation of benefits in 1995, and the electronic benefits transfer in 2009; and






