## I MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN 2019 (FIRST) Regular Session

Resolution No. 736 -35 (COR)

Relative to amending *I Mina'Trentai Singko Na Liheslaturan Guahan Otden Areklamento* (the Thirty-Fifth Guam Legislature Standing Rules) to adopt the applicable provisions of the Department of Administrations Drug-Free Workplace Program as a condition of employment in the *I Mina'Trentai Singko Na Liheslaturan Guahan*.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF A MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, I Liheslaturan Guahan must recognize the reality that we are unfortunately in a period where our community is faced with a drug epidemic, and only if we can accept the circumstances can we focus on fighting this battle with the intent of winning it; and

WHEREAS, it would be inexcusable if *I Liheslaturan Guahan* continues to create policy on issues that are associated with combating the islands drug problem as a whole, if we can't as a policymaking body establish drug free guidelines for the legislative branch of the government, specifically when it comes to requiring it as a condition of employment; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 95-29, signed by former Governor Carl Gutierrez in 1995, emphasized the importance of establishing a comprehensive drug

1 free workplace policy for the government of Guam, unfortunately has not been

2 applied by the legislative branch of the government; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 95-29 resulted in adoption and promulgation of the Department of Administration's Drug-Free Workplace Program Operating Procedures, which includes a mandatory test as a condition of employment in the Government of Guam, random drug testing for designation positions, and procedures for dealing with illegal drug use in the workplace; and

WHEREAS, it is certainly questionable on why the legislative branch does not adopt a Drug-Free Workplace Program when other entities in the executive and judicial branch have similar programs in place, thus it is vital to incorporate a policy based on what already exists with the executive branch, and apply all applicable provisions; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that senators may not be subject to a drug test as a condition of employment, as their position was awarded by the electorate via an election process, and therefore would be exempt from the Drug Free Workplace Program, if *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* was to adopt a similar program for the branch; and

WHEREAS, the enactment of Public Law 32-5 earlier in the year legalized the recreational usage of cannabis on Guam, therefore it would be paramount that any Drug Free Workplace Program adopted by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* exclude the legal substance from the drug testing requirement; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Singko Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam adopt the applicable provisions of the Department of Administrations Drug-Free Workplace Program Operating Procedures as a condition of employment for the *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, and to amend the Standing Rules- Part E, Rule XIV, Section

14.04, by adding a new Subsection (i) to include the provisions of this policy: and be 1 2 it further; RESOLVED, that the Drug-Free Workplace Program Operating Procedures 3 shall be established as a condition of employment for all full and part time employees 4 of I Liheslaturan Guåhan; and be it further 5 RESOLVED, that the Drug-Free Workplace Program Operating Procedures 6 shall not apply to any Senator of the I Liheslaturan Guåhan, as a condition of 7 employment, however any Senator may volunteer to take a drug test as a means to 8 share their commitment to the I Liheslaturan Guåhan's efforts to address the drug 9 epidemic on island; and be it further 10 RESOLVED, that the Department of Administrations Drug-Free Workplace 11 Program Operating Procedures shall exclude the results of cannabis usage as part of 12 the drug testing requirements, as to comply with the provisions of Public Law 32-5, 13 14 and be it further RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules shall have up to ten (10) days from 15 the adoption of this resolution to identify the applicable provisions of the Department 16 of Administration's Drug-Free Workplace Program Operating Procedures, and to 17 promulgate one for I Liheslaturan Guåhan; and be it further 18 RESOLVED, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules 19 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of 20 the same be thereafter transmitted to all Members of I Mina'Trentai Singko Na 21 Liheslaturan Guahan; and to the Honorable Lourdes Leon Guerrero, I Maga'hågan 22 23 Guåhan.
