WHEREAS, Dr. Nathaniel Berg, MD was born in Reykjavik, Iceland; and he comes from a family with a strong interest and background in public health. Dr. Berg earned his M.D. degree from the esteemed Tufts University Medical School in Boston, Massachusetts, after graduating with honors from the University of Massachusetts, Amherst; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Berg began his post-graduate medical training at Letterman Army Medical Center in San Francisco, California, where he completed a surgery qualified transitional internship and went on to complete his Radiology Residency training at the renowned Walter Reed Army Medical Center in Washington, D.C., where he served as Chief Resident in Radiology; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Berg has vigorously pursued continuing his medical education, which included additional training in Interventional Radiology in Malmö, Sweden; and he then served in the United States Army Medical Corps for thirteen (13) years, leaving for private practice on Guam after achieving the rank of Major; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Berg served for four (4) years at the United States Naval Hospital, Guam where he was elected to serve on the Executive Committee of the Medical Staff; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Berg has been a very active member of the medical community on Guam and has served as President of the Guam Medical Society and was the host of a local medical issues-oriented radio program; and while serving as President of the Guam Medical Society, Dr. Berg had organized regional and international conferences; and he is a founding physician of a program that mentors students from Guam who are interested in careers in healthcare; and

WHEREAS, as the current Chairperson of the Guam Board of Medical Examiners, Dr. Berg has led in the efforts to fully digitize the Board's previously paper-based records, to create the Board's first website, and to build an online application and records system. He also directed the process that led to Guam becoming the first territorial member of the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact, an innovative licensing process that offers an expedited pathway to licensure for physicians wishing to practice in multiple states; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Nathaniel Berg is the Medical Director of Guam Radiology Consultants and is Board Certified by the American Board of Radiology. Dr. Berg has published articles on Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) and the role of the Radiologist in preparing for disasters, and he has been invited to present lectures at national and international conferences; and




