WHEREAS, the late Dr. Karri Trahin Perez, was born in July 15, 1959, in New York; and she was a resident of the village of Tamuning until she passed on January 27, 2019, at the age of fifty-nine (59); and

WHEREAS, the late Dr. Karri Trahin Perez was married to Gerry Perez; and is survived by her children, Trish, Tracy, and Alan; and

WHEREAS, the late Dr. Karri Trahin Perez received her Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice and Sociology from Radford University; her Master's Degree in both Organizational Psychology and Business from Radford University and Organizational Development from the Fielding Graduate Institute; her Master of Business Administration from the University of Phoenix; and her Doctorate of Philosophy from the Fielding Graduate Institute; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the late Dr. Karri Trahin Perez was a senior consultant of Allied
2 Business; and she has facilitated more than half a billion dollars' worth of U.S
3 military projects for clients including the Navy, Air Force, Marines, and Army and
4 provided training and consulting services to clients across the globe; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the late Dr. Karri Trahin Perez was a long-serving faculty
6 member at the University of Guam School of Business and Public Administration
7 most recently as an Associate Professor of Global Resources Management. Her
8 mentorship and knowledge had a profound effect on students and colleagues; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the late Dr. Karri Trahin Perez began her career at the University
10 as a Program Coordinator in 1998 and returned as a faculty member in 2007. She has
11 taught numerous courses in both the undergraduate and graduate programs at the
12 University of Guam School of Business and Public Administration; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the late Dr. Karri Trahin Perez is a published author on
14 leadership; and prolific in her professional pursuits, having earned designations as a
15 Project Management Professional (PMP), Senior Professional in Human Resources
16 (SPHR), Global Professional in Human Resources (GPHR), Certified Medical Staff
17 Recruiter, General Banking Diploma from the American Bankers Association, the
18 Member Advisory Council Member (MAC) representing the Asia Pacific region,
19 President of the Society for Human Resource Management's (SHRM) Guam Chapter,
20 Certified Small Business Counselor, Member of the Workforce Investment Act Board,
21 Board Member and Mediator of the Inafa'Maolek Mediation Organization, Founding
22 Member of the Guam Marketing Association, President and Board Member of the
23 Guam Cancer Society, Women Executive of the Year Nominee, Board Member of the
24 Guam Red Cross, and a Certified Tour Guide; and
