BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, the late Dr. Jose Quinene Cruz was a resident of Barrigada Heights and was formerly from the village of Malessu. He is married to Dr. Teofila Sholing Perez, and they have four (4) children; and he passed away on January 6, 2020, at the age of seventy-three (73); and

WHEREAS, in 1969, Dr. Cruz began his extensive career in education serving as a teacher at Mount Carmel Junior High School in Agat. He earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in English from the University of Guam; he earned a graduate certificate in rehabilitation counseling from San Francisco State University; and he received a Doctor of Education degree from Western Michigan University; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Cruz was engaged in educational pursuits at all levels in government, most notably at the University of Guam (UOG) where he began his academic career serving as a part-time Assistant Professor and Instructor of Public Administration and Management at the UOG College of Business and Public Administration from 1979 to 1983. In 1983, he joined Governor Ricardo J. Bordallo's administrative staff and served as a Special Assistant on Education, and Boards and Commissions; and during that year, he was appointed by the UOG Board of Regents to serve as the fifth (5th) UOG President; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Cruz served with distinction as the UOG President from July 1983 to September 1987; and after his term ended, Dr. Cruz remained at the University of Guam and served as a Regents Professor, from October 1987 to August 1989; as an Associate Professor, from August 1989 to September 2002; and as an Adjunct Faculty from August to December 2002; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Cruz was an active member of the Guam Education Board and donated his monthly stipend to local public schools; and in his role as a board member, he played a key part in steering the Guam Department of Education through challenging times, and he had served honorably as the sixth (6th) Chairperson of the Guam Education Board; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Cruz was known for his passion for teaching the next generation and encouraging the community to support the island's education system; now therefore, be it




