WHEREAS, on Guam, *CHamoru* society is traditionally matrilineal, whereby
land and resources were passed through maternal lines of inheritance; and

5 WHEREAS, women on Guam lead in all facets of society, in all the major 6 professions and businesses, and are politically engaged and active in the church and 7 community; and

1 WHEREAS, these extraordinary women anchor us to our CHamoru values and 2 encourage future generations to fight for progress on Guam and around the world on 3 issues such as gender equality, climate change, affordable health care, and better 4 educational and employment opportunities; and

5 WHEREAS, on March 9, 1980, U.S President Jimmy Carter issued a 6 Presidential Proclamation declaring the week of March 8 as the first (1<sup>st</sup>) "*National* 7 *Women's History Week*," honoring and recognizing the contributions of women 8 throughout American history; and

9 WHEREAS, the U.S Congress then designated the month of March 1987 as 10 *"Women's History Month"* and since 1988, U.S Presidents have issued annual 11 proclamations designating the month of March as *"Women's History Month"*; and

WHEREAS, in 2019, Guam made history for having the most women represented in all branches of government with voters electing the island's first female governor, majority women in the legislature, and a female chief justice and federal judge; and

WHEREAS, during Women's History Month, we celebrate the remarkable women locally, nationally, and globally who have overcome barriers and paved the way for women to not only participate in our government, but also, to lead and shape the lives of others and communities in positive ways; and
