WHEREAS, the late Honorable Vann B. Isaac, also known by his chiefly title of "Rechebei ra Tiabed of Ngerkebsang Koror," was born in the Republic of Palau on March 29, 1976; and is the son of Benraik Isaac and Deborah Isaac; and

WHEREAS, the late Honorable Vann B. Isaac attended the Seventh Day Adventist Elementary School; and after completing his high school education at the Palau High School in 1993, the late Honorable Vann B. Isaac received his university education at the San Bernardino Valley College and at the University of Guam; and

WHEREAS, in April 1996, the late Honorable Vann B. Isaac began his long history of public service working very closely with the President and Vice President of Palau as a researcher for the National Emergency Management Office. He then served as a Senate Page for the Olbiil Era Kelulau in 2012 and was later elected to serve his first term in the Tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) Koror State Legislature in January 2014, where he held the Vice Chairmanship position of the Committee on Youth Affairs and the Committee on National and State Relations; and also served as a member of the Committee on Ways and Means, the Committee on Tourism, and the Committee on Capital Improvement Projects; and

WHEREAS, the late Honorable Vann B. Isaac would later serve his second term as a Legislator in the Tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) Koror State Legislature representing Ikela Hamlet, where he served as Chairman of the Committee on Tourism, Vice Chairman of the Committee on Resources and Development, Member of the Committee on Judiciary and Government Affairs, and Member of the Committee on Youth Affairs; and




