AND MINISTRY TO THE PEOPLE OF GUAM.**

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA***
2 ***LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Majors Thomas and Kimberly Stambaugh, since July of 2016,
4 have brought about renewed commitment to The Salvation Army's dedication to
5 help those in the most need on Guam. Their dedication along with their hardworking
6 staff, volunteers, and Advisory Board members continue to help thousands of people
7 in need of food assistance through the ongoing unprecedented COVID-19 Pandemic;
8 and

9 **WHEREAS**, in 2018, under the leadership of Majors Thomas and Kimberly
10 Stambaugh, the Lighthouse Recovery Center, with the help of Recovery Center
11 Director Valerie Reyes and Program Coordinator Lourdes Hongyee, was awarded a
12 \$2.2 Million Dollar grant from Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Agency
13 (GHURA) for the purpose of building a fourteen (14) bed Women's Residential
14 Substance Abuse Treatment facility, expanding treatment capacity of the Lighthouse
15 Recovery Center, to include women in need of residential substance abuse treatment.

1 **WHEREAS**, under the leadership of Majors Thomas and Kimberly
2 Stambaugh, The Salvation Army’s religious and faith based programs, including
3 church services that provide a place for all to come and all are welcome to gain
4 biblical understanding and applicability in the daily lives of Christians, and youth
5 programs, including after school activities, day camp, and character-building
6 programs, designed to help enrich youth throughout the island community have been
7 reinvigorated and revitalized;

8 **WHEREAS**, under the leadership of Majors Thomas and Kimberly
9 Stambaugh, The Salvation Army Guam Corps has partnered with government
10 agencies such as; Department of Labor, Department of Public Health and Social
11 Services, Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center, Guam Housing and Urban
12 Renewal Authority, Guam Memorial Hospital, United States Probation Office,
13 Superior Court Adult Drug Court, Veterans Administration, KUAM News, Senator
14 Regine Biscoe Lee, Senator Will Castro, in various community outreach efforts;

15 **WHEREAS**, during the command of Majors Thomas and Kimberly
16 Stambaugh, in addition to its regular offerings, The Salvation Army also coordinated
17 with local and federal authorities and offered assistance with typhoons and other
18 disasters through its Emergency Disaster Services Team; and has participated in
19 numerous disaster and relief efforts, including Typhoon Soudelor in 2015, Typhoons
20 Yutu and Mangkhut in 2018, and Typhoon Wutip in 2019, and provided food
21 assistance to thousands of people in the ongoing 2020 Coronavirus Pandemic; now
22 therefore be it; and

24 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize Majors Thomas and Kimberly
25 Stambaugh for their four (4) years of service to the people of Guam; and be it further;
