



2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth C. Perez was born on April 11, 1962 and is the son of
4 Benito J. and Rufina C. Perez; and is from the village of *Hagatña*; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth C. Perez is the spouse of Elsa S. Perez, who are
6 blessed with three (3) sons and one (1) daughter; Zion, Arron, Isaiah, and Camarin; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth C. Perez graduated from Father Dueñas Memorial
8 School in the year 1980. Mr. Perez went on to serve our great nation of the United States
9 as a Medical Service Specialist in the United States Air Force having been first stationed
10 in Sheppard Air Force Base in Texas; he then continued to serve our nation's people as
11 a Medical Specialist stationed at the Travis Air Force Base in Fairfield, CA; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in the month of September 1991 Mr. Kenneth C. Perez began his
13 public service career for the Government of Guam working as a Licensed Practical

1 Nurse I for the Guam Memorial Hospital where he provided much needed care and
2 medical expertise to our community for seventeen (17) years; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth C. Perez, since August 2008, has continued to serve
4 our community by providing care for our youth as a School Health Counselor at Okkodo
5 High School. With his years of experience in the medical field Mr. Perez has provided
6 school nursing care to a student population of one thousand seven hundred (1,700)
7 students; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Kenneth C. Perez in his years of medical experience and
9 service for both these great United States of America and the People of Guam, in
10 addition to his membership and volunteerism in such organizations, including amongst
11 others: the Guam Federation of Teachers, American Federation of Teachers, and the
12 National Association of School Nurses, has provided invaluable medical care to our
13 community; and on July 31, 2020 retired from the Guam Department of Education now,
14 therefore be it

15 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Singko Na*
16 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
17 of Guam, recognize Kenneth C. Perez for his service to the nation as a medical
