3 **WHEREAS,** Jesus Macaraeg Epres was born on December 25, 1965 in the city
4 of Manila, Philippines and is the daughter of Saturnino Orpiano Macaraeg and
5 Carmelita Rivera Prado. She relocated to Guam in the year 1969 and has been a member
6 of our island community since; and

7 **WHEREAS,** Jesusa Macaraeg Epres is the spouse of Francis Victor Epres who
8 are blessed with two (2) sons; Jesson John Epres, and Luineo James Epres; and

9 **WHEREAS,** Jesusa Macaraeg Epres attended John F. Kennedy and Simon
10 Sanchez high school; and went on to pursue her higher education at the University of
11 Guam; and

12 **WHEREAS,** Jesusa Macaraeg Epres received her Associates of Science in
13 Nursing (ASN); and received her Registered Nurse Licensure and Licensed Practical
14 Nurse Licensure from the University of Guam; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Jesus Macaraeg Epres upon completing her education at the
2 University of Guam began her public service career as a Staff Registered Nurse I in the
3 surgical ward of the Guam Memorial Hospital in the year 1989. She continued within
4 the medical field on Guam providing care for countless individuals within our
5 community at both the Guam Memorial Hospital and the Department of Public Health
6 and Social Services for sixteen (16) years before transferring to the Guam Department
7 of Education in the year 2005 where she has since served as School Health Counselor
8 II at B.P. Carbullido Elementary School; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Jesus Macaraeg Epres has contributed to the community
10 tremendously through her membership and volunteerism in organizations, including
11 amongst others: the National Association of School Nurses, Guam Nurses Association,
12 American Nurses Association, and American Heart Association – Jump Rope for Heart;
13 and through her invaluable expertise within the medical field has provided much needed
14 care for our children and for our community; and on June 30, 2020 retired from the
15 Guam Department of Education; now, therefore be it
