3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Antonette Muña Santos, or Toni as she is better known, was
4 born on August 19, 1961, to Akimi and Frank Muña in Koza City, Okinawa; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Muña Santos and her family moved to the island of Guam
6 where she attended San Vincente Catholic School and George Washington High school;
7 and

8 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Muña Santos graduated from George Washington High in
9 1979, and married Francisco Santos in 1985. Together they would have (3) children
10 Frank, Mariana and Nicholas Santos; two (2) grandchildren Aryana and Olivia; and six
11 (6) dogs, Sofie, Koa, Max, Jet, Bella, and Magas; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Muña Santos' career of public service began at the Guam
13 Community College (GCC) in March 1981 as a Clerk Typist II for the Bureau of Human
14 Service and Career Center. She was promoted the following year as an Accounting
15 Clerk for the Management Service and Business Office, where she worked for seven

1 and a half years. Mrs. Santos spent the remainder of her career at GCC working as an
2 Accounting Technician I (1990-1991), a Personnel Assistant I (1991), and then as a
3 Personnel Assistant II (1998) until transfer to the Guam Water Works Authority (GWA)
4 in May 1998; and

5 **WHEREAS**, upon her transfer to GWA, she was promoted to Personnel
6 Specialist II at the Office of the General Manager and Human Resource Division (1998-
7 2001). While at the Office of the General Manager and Human resource division Mrs.
8 Santos was elevated to Personnel Specialist III in January 2001 and was later appointed
9 to serve as a Personnel Specialist IV in April 2004; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Santos was transferred to the University of Guam's
11 Administrative & Finance Human resources division on December 27, 2004, where she
12 served as the Chief Human Resources Officer for the University of Guam. After
13 working as the University's Chief Human Resources Officer for three (3) years. Mrs.
14 Santos was later detailed to serve as the Acting Assistant Personnel Services
15 Administrator for Guam's Public School System Personnel Service Division in 2008;
16 and

17 **WHEREAS**, In January 2010, Mrs. Santos was appointed to serve as the
18 Personnel Services Administrator for the Guam Department of Education's Personnel
19 Services Division, where she has worked for nearly eleven and a half years; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Santos is currently scheduled to retire from the Government
21 of Guam on September 18, 2020. Mrs. Muña Santos looks forward to watching her
22 grandchildren Aryana and Olivia grow and traveling in her retirement years; now
23 therefore, be it

25 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize Mrs. Antonette Muña Santos on the
