1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN***  
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Eloise R. Sanchez a native woman of Guam. Her parents are  
4 Jesus Rivera and Angustia Tainatongo River (deceased). She has two (2) older brothers  
5 and one (1) younger sister. She is married to Mike Sanchez and they have two (2)  
6 children: Lisa Alicto and Michael Sanchez. She has one grandchild Lilah Alicto; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Sanchez has dedicated years of service to the Guam  
8 Department of Education (GDOE). She has gone above and beyond for the children of  
9 Guam. Her career began in 1984 as a First-Grade teacher at M.U Lujan Elementary  
10 School. Then in 1985 to 1993 she continued working at the elementary school as a  
11 Kindergarten teacher; and

12 **WHEREAS**, her professionalism and commitment to building strong  
13 educational foundations for young children paved the way for her to become a  
14 consultant for Early Childhood Education from 1993-1997. In this capacity she  
15 provided support to kindergarten through fifth grade teachers by facilitating meetings,

1 workshops, provided materials and resource development to further Early Childhood  
2 Education curriculum, program, and professional development; and

3       **WHEREAS**, her career at GDOE is worthy of great praise. In 1998 to 2008, she  
4 was the Associate Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction for the Guam  
5 Department of Education overseeing Curriculum, Program and Professional  
6 Development. While assuming leadership roles in GDOE she has also been a part-time  
7 instructor of education at the University of Guam and Guam Community College. As a  
8 professional in her field, she is a member of several advisory boards: the School of  
9 Education Advisory Committee, the Education Advisory Board for the Early Childhood  
10 Education Program with the Guam Community College, and the Institutional Research  
11 Board (IRB) with the University of Guam. She is also a former member of the State  
12 Rehabilitation Council. As a supporter of her faith, she engaged in Confraternity of  
13 Christian Doctrine (CCD), teaching religious education to young parishioners; and

14       **WHEREAS**, to further enumerate Mrs. Sanchez’s successful career, from 2008-  
15 2020 she is currently the School Program Consultant with the Guam Department of  
16 Education’s Division of Curriculum & Instruction. She is responsible for the following  
17 programs: Joint Board Union, Business Technology, Service- Learning Program, Early  
18 Childhood Education, School Library Program and Facilitates the District’s Curriculum  
19 & Textbook Committee. As she concludes her career at GDOE Mrs. Sanchez will be  
20 missed fondly amongst her colleagues and friends as she trails onward with her latest  
21 journey-retirement; and

22       **WHEREAS**, her ability to recognize the value of pursuing a dedicated career in  
23 the Guam Department of Education has benefitted the children of Guam for decades.  
24 Her leadership has continued to help the department provide critical services to the  
25 island community; now, therefore be it

2 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize Mrs. Eloise R. Sanchez on the occasion of
