1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2        ***MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3        **WHEREAS**, the late Renie M. Tumanda, passed away at the age of forty-five  
4        (45) years, on Friday, September 25, 2020, leaving behind not only a grieving family  
5        and community, but also remembered for his dedicated service and love for the people  
6        of Guam and the Island; and

7        **WHEREAS**, the late Renie M. Tumanda, was born on November 24, 1974, to  
8        Mr. and Mrs. Felicidad and Manuel Tumanda and has two (2) siblings Richard and  
9        Ray Tumanda; and

10       **WHEREAS**, the late Renie M. Tumanda, is married to Divina Leones, and has  
11       three (3) children, Eben Marlee, Isabella and Devin Paul; whom he loved and  
12       cherished and resided at 160 Chalan Paraisu, in Yigo; and

13       **WHEREAS**, the late Renie M. Tumanda, has sacrificed his life and given six  
14       (6) years of service, to the Guam Customs and Quarantine Agency and the people of  
15       Guam; as a Customs Officer I, who was a part of several narcotic seizures; prohibited  
16       and dangerous goods seizures; invasive species seizures, and part of a team that has

1 aided in the Quarantine and First Line of Defense, that has protected many of our  
2 People, and saved our Flora and Fauna; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Renie M. Tumanda, was a Fisherman, his love for fishing,  
4 since he was a young man, has touched many people of Guam, as he is remembered as  
5 a generous Fisherman, whom while walking, the beaches of Tumon, would check on  
6 the Elderly Fishermen, who had no luck all day, would generously give his entire  
7 catch to that person, so he can feed himself and his family; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the late Renie M. Tumanda, was a Coach for the Simon A.  
9 Sanchez Volleyball and Cross-Country Team, that Mentored, in shaping our Youth in  
10 sports, to become outstanding athletes that has represented Guam; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the late Renie M. Tumanda, was a man whom loved to share his  
12 knowledge about, fishing, cycling, and swimming, as well; as his love for animals,  
13 especially his love for Chickens. He assisted many friends and strangers with his  
14 Knowledge and gave up hours to help them, when called upon; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the late Renie M. Tumanda, has a Huge Heart, with Devotion,  
16 Love and Friendship for the Island and the Community, as our fellow brother in arms,  
17 and a friend to everyone, who always showed respect and kindness to everyone he  
18 met; referring to his elders as Auntie or Nana, Uncle or Tata; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the late Renie M. Tumanda was the 41<sup>st</sup> person whose life was  
20 tragically cut short, because of the Corona Virus Pandemic; and

21 **WHEREAS**, a member of the first line of Defense, a Law Enforcement Officer,  
22 made the ultimate sacrifice, to ensure that Commerce does not stop, and our Island  
23 and People receive their goods for sustainability; for his service, he will be  
24 remembered forever, now therefore be it,

25 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Singko Na*  
26 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, posthumously

1 recognize the late Renie M. Tumanda for his years of dedicated service to the people  
2 of Guam; and to further extend our sincerest condolences to his family on the occasion  
3 of his passing, and be it further

4 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chair of the Committee on Rules certify,  
5 and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same
