1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Ana Maria Cruz Senato is originally from the village of Maite  
4 and currently resides in Mangilao; and she is the daughter of Severina Apuron Cruz and  
5 Juan Ogo Cruz; and

6           **WHEREAS**, Ana Senato and her husband, Mr. Edwin Senato, have been married  
7 for 23 years and raised a beautiful family of five children and seven grandchildren; and

8           **WHEREAS**, Ana Senato attended Cathedral Grade School from 1964-1966,  
9 Barrigada Junior High, now known as Untalan Middle School, from 1969-1971, George  
10 Washington High School and Academy of our Lady of Guam from 1971-1972; she  
11 relocated and graduated in 1974 from Valley High School in Santa Ana, California;  
12 after graduation, Ana Senato worked at the Hawaii State Office in Big Island, Hawaii,  
13 where she also attended Hawaii Community College; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Ana Senato began her public service in the Government of Guam  
2 in March 1993, where she worked as a Legislative Assistant III at the Guam Legislature;  
3 six months later, she was promoted to Legislative Assistant IV until 1995; and

4           **WHEREAS**, Ana Senato served as a Private Secretary at the Guam Energy  
5 Office in 1997; a year later, she was promoted and served four years as a Program  
6 Coordinator I; she received another promotion in 2002 as a Program Coordinator II; and

7           **WHEREAS**, in January 2009, Mrs. Ana Senato transferred from the Guam  
8 Energy office to the Department of Public Works, Office of Highway Safety as a  
9 Program Coordinator, where she shared her extensive years of knowledge and  
10 experience; she managed many highway safety programs with other Government of  
11 Guam agencies; with the Guam Police Department-Highway Patrol Division, she  
12 helped with Police Traffic (Operation H.E.A.T.), Alcohol (DUI/Impaired Driving), and  
13 Occupant Protection (Click It or Ticket/Operation Buckle Down); with the Port  
14 Authority of Guam - Port Police Division, she helped with Police Traffic (Operation  
15 Adai he' hao!); with the Guam International Airport Authority – Airport Police  
16 Division, she helped with Police Traffic (Traffic Enforcement Project); with the Guam  
17 Fire Department, she helped with Emergency Medical (Extrication Equipment Project),  
18 and with the Office of the Attorney General, she helped with DUI Prosecutor project  
19 and Roadway Safety; and

20           **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Ana Senato performed beyond the call of her duty as she  
21 served as a nationally certified Child Passenger Safety Technician from 2010 to 2018,  
22 which was a part of the Occupant Protection program initiative for greater safety while  
23 driving and riding on Guam's roadways; she was a part of the team that conducted  
24 educational awareness at schools and various events held in both the public and private  
25 community, which was all a part of the strategy that profiled Guam as one of the highest  
26 rate of seat belt use for the nation and its territories; Ana Senato has attained national

1 credential as one of the island’s 50 Child Passenger Safety Technicians and is also  
2 recognized as one of the 41,000 nationally certified Child Passenger Safety  
3 Technicians; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Ana Senato is a current member of the National Association of  
5 Women Highway Safety Leaders Inc.; she voluntarily served as Treasurer for DPW’s  
6 Employees Association and an officer for the Family Readiness Organization for “Fox  
7 Trot Unit” and “Hulo Unit” of the National Guard; and

8 **WHEREAS**, on September 30, 2020, Mrs. Ana Maria Cruz Senato will retire  
9 from an outstanding career with the Government of Guam after serving over 25  
10 dedicated and committed years of service now, therefore be it

11 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Singko Na*  
12 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
13 of Guam, recognize and congratulate Mrs. Ana Maria Cruz Senato on her retirement
