1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, the Catholic Daughters of the Americas (CDA) is one of the oldest
4 and largest organizations of Catholic women in the nation, and are united by their faith
5 in Jesus Christ under the patronage of the Blessed Mother; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Catholic Daughters of the Americas dedicate themselves to
7 being the helping hands where there is pain, poverty, sorrow, or sickness. Guam’s
8 Catholic Daughters of the Americas are a vibrant and integral part of today’s church,
9 taking their time and effort to help make the lives of all Guam residents better. A
10 Catholic Daughter uses her gifts to follow the motto of “Unity and Charity,” working
11 for her church, family, friends and communities in the most loving way. They strive to
12 embrace the principle of faith, working through love in the promotion of justice,
13 equality, and the advancement of human rights and human dignity for all; and

14 **WHEREAS**, as we celebrate the hundred seventeenth (117th) year anniversary
15 of the chartering of the Catholic Daughters of the Americas, they are reminded of the
16 many religions, charitable and educational contributions the organization has made.

1 They also celebrate the Catholic Daughters of the Americas’ forty-eight (48) years of
2 service to our island community with the local presence established in January 1972.
3 Since then, the local chapter has grown to be a dedicated group of women who serve
