**BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN:**

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable Mark Francis Cura Hamoy's diplomatic career began at the Philippine Department of Foreign Affairs, serving at the Office of ASEAN Affairs from 2002 to 2005, handling the Economic Cooperation Division; and

**WHEREAS**, from 2005 to 2011, Consul Hamoy assumed duties at the Embassy of the Philippines in Amman, Jordan where he served as Third Secretary and Vice Consul from November 2005 to June 2009, soon thereafter he became Second Secretary and Consul from June 2009 to June 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, from July 2011 to January 2014, Consul Hamoy then served as the Special Assistant to the Undersecretary at the Office of the Undersecretary for International Economic Relations where he headed the Economic Diplomacy Unit; and

1           **WHEREAS**, in January 2014, Consul Hamoy's tour of duty at the Consulate  
2 General of the Philippines in Agana (Guam, USA) began on January 25, 2014, where  
3 he was in charge of Economic, Cultural, and Public Diplomacy; and

4           **WHEREAS**, Consul Hamoy's time on Guam was extended as he assumed  
5 the role of Acting Head of Post in the Consulate General of the Philippines in Agana,  
6 leading the office during a critical time. He continued to provide guidance and  
7 consular services to members of the Filipino community as well as residents seeking  
8 assistance during this critical time; and

9           **WHEREAS**, Consul Hamoy's education prepared him to lead under these  
10 situations having received a Bachelor of Arts in Communication Arts from the  
11 University of the Philippines, Los Baños, Laguna in 1993 and Complementary  
12 Studies in Management Diploma in 1999 and Master of Business Administration in  
13 2000 both at Katholieke Universiteit Leuven in Belgium; and

14           **WHEREAS**, Consul Hamoy was born in Manila, he is married to Leah  
15 Soledad Mendoza Hamoy and has a daughter and a son; and

16           **WHEREAS**, Consul Hamoy's invaluable work on our island has fostered a  
17 closer relationship between the people of Guam and the people of the Philippines.  
18 Consul Hamoy now leaves Guam to begin his post as Career Minister; now  
19 therefore, be it

20           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'trentai Singko Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does  
21 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize the Honorable Mark Francis  
22 Cura Hamoy, Consul of the Philippine Consulate General in Agana, Guam; and to  
23 further expressing an *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* and *Maraming Salamat Po*  
24 to him and his exemplary service and contributions to the island of Guam and the  
25 region; and be it further
