1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN***
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Henry Imaizumi San Nicolas, also known as “Jun” or
4 “Henry O”, was born on April 17, 1971 and is the son of Dorothy Imaizumi and Henry
5 Borja San Nicolas; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the late Henry I. San Nicolas was called to rest on November 4,
7 2020 and is survived by his wife, Katrina Lynn Charfauros and their children, Shaianae,
8 Shane, Savannah, and Shawn, as well as their spouses and children; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the late Henry I. San Nicolas was employed with the Defense
10 Commissary Agency (DECA), Americold Logistics, the Navy Exchange Distribution
11 Center and DZSP 21 LLC for a total of 19 years and 4 months of private, federal and
12 civil service employment prior to being employed at the Port; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Mr. San Nicolas became employed by the Port on January 27, 2014
14 where he began his public service career as a Cargo Checker for the Port Authority of
15 Guam. Mr. San Nicolas’ sense of humor, kindness, energy and graciousness enriched
16 those fortunate enough to know and work with him; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Henry I. San Nicolas was a Frontline Hero and a COVID
2 Warrior who was loved by his Port Strong Family and the Jose D. Leon Guerrero
3 Commercial Port and the entire community of Guam lost a valued member on
4 November 4, 2020, with the death of Mr. San Nicolas; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Henry I. San Nicolas will always be remembered for his smile,
6 kindness, and dedication to his family, friends, and his Port Strong Family with his true
7 legacy being the profound effect he had on those who loved him; now, therefore be it

9 on behalf of the people of Guam, posthumously honor the life of Port Authority of
10 Guam employee Henry I. San Nicolas and recognize his contributions to public service;
