1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Romana Blas Villagomez was born on February 29, 1920 in the
4 heart of *Hagatna, Guam*, and is the daughter of Rosa Pereira Crisostomo and Jesus
5 Santos Blas. Romana, fondly known as “Auntie Ana/Nana”, is formerly from the village
6 of *Hagatna*, and presently resides with her daughter Louise V. Perez in *Barrigada*,
7 where she has resided for the past ten (10) years; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Romana was married to the love of her life, Pedro Perez
9 Villagomez, for thirty-three (30) years until his unfortunate passing on September 18,
10 1976; and she has remained committed to her vows and never remarried; and

11 **WHEREAS, Romana**, is the matriarch of her family, and is affectionately know
12 as “Auntie Romana” to her nieces and nephews. She has always lived a very simple life.
13 She has (3) three children Rosa, Louise and Carl. She has six (6) granddaughters, three
14 (3) grandsons and has been abundantly blessed with two (2) great-grandchildren.

1 **WHEREAS**, Romana was a homemaker who, for the most part, enjoyed raising
2 her children; and she is affectionately known as “Nana” to her family. She loved to sew.
3 She was very skilled and hard working with her sewing. She enjoyed the seam work
4 and intricacy of each stitch. As mother she made many outfits for each of her children.
5 She has also made prom dresses for each of her daughters. Evidently being a mother
6 was a never ending task. She was also certainly a very great cook – dinner rolls bread
7 was one of her specialties at family and friend gatherings. It was an essential dish to
8 bring and many individuals were indulged in her dinner roll bread; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Romana also likes to reminisce and tell stories of World War II;
10 and she has always been a devout Catholic who attended Mass every Sunday. Although
11 she may not attend Mass regularly, Romana still donates to the Santa Barbara Church
12 in Dededo and Our Lady of Lourdes Church in Yigo; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Romana always remained committed to her faith and her spouse.
14 She was a simple woman who helped those in need; and although she had stopped doing
15 the activities she had loved to do when she turned ninety (90) years old, she continues
16 to have her strength and independence; now therefore, be it

17 **WHEREAS**, the “Senior Citizens Month” is traditionally celebrated in the month
18 of May, due to the ongoing pandemic, it was postponed for health and safety concerns
19 and now therefore, be it

20 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'trentai Singko Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
21 on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, recognize Romana Blas
22 Villagomez on celebrating one hundred (100) years of longevity; and commemorate her
23 as a Centenarian of the 2020 “Senior Citizens Month” celebration; and be it further

24 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the
25 adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Romana Blas
26 Villagomez; and to the Honorable Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero, *I Maga'hågan Guåhan*.
