1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2        ***MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3        **WHEREAS**, Jose Aguinaldo Peralta was born on July 18, 1920; and is the son  
4        of Modesta Aguinaldo Peralta and Sebastian Peralta. Jose Aguinaldo Peralta, fondly  
5        known as Jose, is formerly from the *Pangasinan* province of *Philippines*, and currently  
6        lives with his wife Juanita Sevila Peralta in *Dededo*, where he has resided for the past  
7        twenty (20) years; and

8        **WHEREAS**, Jose was married to the love of his life Juanita Sevila Peralta for  
9        sixty-eight (68) years; and he has remained committed to his vows. Jose continues to  
10       live his life day by day with his (8) children, Hildalita Obias (deceased), Jose Jr.  
11       (deceased), Elena Myrna Burlingame, Ricardo, Nita Jeanette Cepeda, Johnny  
12       (deceased), Harriet Javier and has been blessed with (18) eighteen grandchildren and  
13       (10) ten great-grandchildren; and

1           **WHEREAS**, *Jose* established Star Press General Printer in Tamuning. As a small  
2 businessman he took pride in the business and it being a family facilitated operation.  
3 Star Press General Printers was also operated with his older brother Segundo, he and  
4 his wife made it their mission to help the relative back in the Philippines by sending  
5 money to make sure they had “pasulubong” whenever mom made trips back to Barrio.

6           **WHEREAS**, Jose was a great man, he was a humble, quiet man who took part  
7 in many organizations. He was an active member of the following organizations Rotary  
8 Club of *Tumon Guam*, Filipino Community of *Guam*, Ilocano Association of Guam.  
9 He enjoyed the camaraderie of the fellow Filipinos, who made *Guam* their home; and

10           **WHEREAS**, Jose enjoyed planting vegetables and gardening in the back yard.  
11 In fact, he would walk up and down the garden to exercise. He grew onions, peppers,  
12 eggplants and many other vegetables.

13           **WHEREAS**, the “Senior Citizens Month” is traditionally celebrated in the month  
14 of May but due to the ongoing pandemic, it was postponed for health and safety  
15 concerns and now therefore, be it

16           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'trentai Singko Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,  
17 on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, recognize Jose Aguinardo  
18 Peralta on celebrating one hundred (100) years of longevity; and commemorate her as  
19 a Centenarian of the 2020 “Senior Citizens Month” celebration; and be it further

20           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the  
21 adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Jose Aguinardo
