1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Filemon Catabay Carino was born on March 20, 1920; and is the
4 son of Juana Catabay and Alejandro Carino. Filemon Catabay Carino, fondly known as
5 *Filemon*, is formerly from the *Philippines*, and currently lives with his wife in *Maina*,
6 where he has resided for the past seven (20) years; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Filemon was married to his first love of his life, Ms. Elisa A.
8 Carino, for (68) years until her unfortunate passing in February 2015; and remarried
9 to Mrs. Adelina J. Carino and have been graciously married for 4 years; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Filemon, had (4) four children with his first wife, Gloria C. Devera,
11 Willie A. Cariono, Gene A. Carino and Linda Mae Carino. Filemon was also blessed
12 with (16) sixteen grandchildren and (29) twenty-nine great grandchildren; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Filemon was an electrician who enjoyed working at the U.S. Naval
2 Ship Repair Facilities and would conclude his career retiring as a supervisor at the
3 naval ship yard.; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Filemon has always been a devout Catholic who attended Mass
5 every Sunday. Although he may not attend Mass regularly now, Filemon was a very
6 active individual who did not like to impose on anyone. He served as the president of
7 the parish council: Our Lady of Purification, *Maina*. He was not a “homebody” he took
8 joy in helping others and staying active with church functions. He remains committed
9 to the Catholicism and remains faithful to the church. He also was a president of the
10 Boliano Bani Fam – Organization of *Guam*.; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Filemon has always remained committed to his faith and his
12 spouses. His first and second wife were both simple women who helped those in need;
13 and although his first wife has passed away, his second wife has not stopped doing the
14 activities he had loved to do when they were together, he continues to have his strength
15 and independence; now therefore, be it

16 **WHEREAS**, the “Senior Citizens Month” is traditionally celebrated in the month
17 of May, due to the ongoing pandemic, it was postponed for health and safety concerns
18 and now therefore, be it

19 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'trentai Singko Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
20 on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, recognize Felecisema
21 Alcira Montalban on celebrating one hundred (100) years of longevity; and
